plete Time-Table, and all the information that is
necessary to enable them to travel freely and
comfortably from place to place.

The Advertisements published will also denote
the Chief Hotels, Places of Amusement, Business
Houses, etc.

The Places of Interest notified on a Special Page
should be read with pleasure, as all the important
points on each route are drawn attention to.
There are also many pleasant spots that will come
under the notice of visitors as the natural and
artificial beauties of Ballarat expand themselves
to them. One of the chief features is the altitude
of the City, which gives, under ordinary condi-
tions, a temperature in the summer months that
is incomparable with any other place in the State.
One can live in comfort in Ballarat, whilst their
less fortunate citizens who cannot avail them-
selves of a week-end trip are suffering the dis-
comforts of the metropolis and other cities less
advantageously placed. In addition to this you
have the attractions of a beautiful City wherein,
and in the vicinity, can be found many avenues
of pleasure, the whole assisting to make the title
of "Queen of Inland Cities," which Ballarat holds,
well and deservedly earned.

The Tramway System commands the entire
City and environs, and is run on up-to-date lines,
giving every facility for the rapid transit of
visitors to the many places of attraction.

Visitors are welcomed at all times by the
officials at the Traffic Office at the Terminus at
Grenville Street, where all information can be
obtained, and at which place is displayed in the
outside waiting room a large diagram showing
plainly the various Tramway Routes.

Time-Tables can be obtained gratis at the Power
Station, Grenville Street Terminus, or at the
Company's Show Room, 330 Sturt Street.

PLACES OF INTEREST ON EACH ROUTE.

Take Car to Gardens via Convent (GREEN DISC)—For Hospital, Roman Catholic Bishop's Palace, Convent, St. Patrick's College, Ballarat College, Golf Links, Hospital for Insane, Fish Acclimatisation Ponds, Municipal Abattoirs, Mt. Holved Smith, Victoria Park, Botanic Gardens, Statuary Pavilion, Fernery, Lake Wendouree (good Boating and Fishing).

Take Car to Gardens via Ripon Street (RED DISC)—For City Bowling Green, Hospital, Electric Power Supply Station, Boat Sheds and Rowing Clubs, Nazareth House, Lake Wendouree (good boating and fishing), Agricultural Show Grounds, Car Depot, C. of E. Bishop's Palace, C. of E. Grammar School, Monastery, St. Aidan's College, Ballarat Common (fine open country), Botanic Gardens, Statuary Pavilion, Fernery.

Take Car to Sebastopol and Rubicon Street (Sebastopol, BLUE, WHITE CENTRE; Rubicon Street, BLUE)—For Open Country Walks at Sebastopol Terminus, pleasant 4-miles tram journey; St. Joseph's Home and Model Farm, Edwards' Pyrites Works, old and active Gold Mines, Woollen Mills, Benevolent Asylum, Miners' Racecourse, Hospital, City Bowling Green.

Take Car to Lydiard Street North (AMBER DISC)—For Doveton Woollen Mills, Brickworks, Ronaldson's Foundry, New Cemetery (half-mile beyond Terminus), North Ballarat and Soldiers' Hill Bowling Greens, Government Workshops, pleasant walks over Hills adjacent to Terminus, including Black Hill.

Take Car to Orphanage (GREEN DISC)—For Roman Catholic Institutions, St. Alipius Church, Convent, Victoria United Mine, Old Curiosity Shop, Eureka Stockade, Tile and Pottery Works, Orphanage, Farmers' Bacon Factory, Cowley's Foundry, Black Hill.

Take Car to Mount Pleasant (RED DISC)—For Pleasant Walks and Fine Views from Mount Pleasant Heights' Observatory, Ballarat East Bowling Green (Electric Light), Woollen Mill.

Take Car to Drummond Street North (WHITE DISC)—For Hospital, City Bowling Green, Old Cemetery, Government Work Shops, Lake Wendouree, Boat Sheds.

NOTES TO PASSENGERS.

Passengers are particularly requested to see that they receive from the Conductor a Ticket showing the amount of fare paid. The Ticket must be freshly torn from the block and punched in their presence, and in the Section over which the passenger is to travel. Each time a Ticket is punched a bell should ring. Tickets (excepting Transfers) are only available for the journey and on the car upon which they are issued, and after its completion it is requested that they be destroyed and not left on the car.

Each passenger must show his ticket when requested by the Conductor, Inspector, or other duly authorised officer of the Company, and shall also, when required, either deliver up his ticket or pay the fare legally demanded for the distance travelled by such passenger.

Passengers travelling beyond the stage to which they have previously paid their fare must pay the full fare for the stage in which they are then travelling.

Cars will stop only at fixed stopping places, or by request at other stopping places so indicated. Any person getting on or off the cars when in these points or entering or leaving car when in motion will do so at their own risk. Passengers are requested, when alighting, to face the direction in which the car is travelling.

To avoid delay passengers are requested to give early notice to Conductor as to the point they wish to get off car.

All articles found in the car must be handed to Conductor. Passengers losing any article whilst travelling on the car must apply for same at the Traffic Office at Grenville Street. Booking fee for each article 3d.

Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the saloon of any car.

All information regarding Private Cars and the fixing of Advertisements, both inside and outside cars, and the charges in connection therewith, can be obtained at the Power Station, Wendouree Parade.

To ensure the free working of the cars, Motor-men and Conductors are strictly forbidden to

allow passengers to ride on the platform of cars, and the public are requested to assist the servants of the Company in carrying out their duty in this respect.

Passengers are notified that Conductors are not compelled to give change for coins of large value on the cars.

The Company do not bind themselves to strictly adhere to the departure times in this Time-Table, but will run as closely to them as possible.

The services may be augmented and continued later at busy times to suit traffic requirements.

Any passenger having cause to complain of any incivility, brusqueness of manner, or curt demeanour on the part of any of the Company's servants are requested to communicate in writing to the Manager, Power Station, Wendouree Parade, 'Phone 350, or to the Traffic Superintendent at 330 Sturt Street, 'Phone 707.



Note.—On a hot summer's night a very pleasant three quarters of an hour can be spent by taking one of the open cars on the Gardens Routes and doing the Round Trip This method is very popular.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO PASSENGERS.

Under the By-Laws which the Company run their cars passengers are liable to be prosecuted for—

Smoking on prohibited portion of car.

Soliciting alms, playing any musical instrument, or distributing handbills or posters.

Attempting to ride on a car whilst in an intoxicated condition.

Using obscene or offensive language.

Obstructing, impeding, threatening, or hindering any officer or servant of the Company in the execution of his duty.

Soiling or damaging car, removing fastenings, defacing notices or advertisements in car.

Attempting to ride on a car if passenger's clothes are in such a condition as to injure the clothes of others.

Attempting to ride, drive, or lead any horse, cart, carriage, or other vehicle on the tram track in front of car, and so impede the progress of same.

Interfering with, or removing or altering any portion of tram track, tramway, or works connected therewith; placing or throwing stones or other missiles on track or at cars.

Attempting to ride without payment of the legal fare, or failing to deliver up ticket to officer when demanded.

Attempting to enter or leave a car whilst in motion.

Carrying loaded firearms, paints, oils, glass, etc., or other offensive goods on cars.

Attempting to enter or leave fare box cars at any other than the front end of car.

Attempting to evade payment by not placing legal fare in fare box.

Opening or otherwise interfering with the gates of a fare box car.

Riding on steps of a fare box car.

Holding on to a car whilst riding a bicycle.

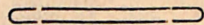

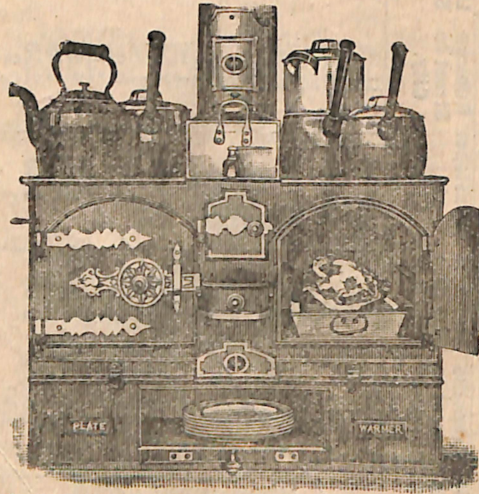
