


FIG. 2.—CANOPY SWITCH WITH COVER OFF.

Canopy Switch, Style No. 5437, has now been superseded by Canopy Switch, Style No. 5409, which differs from the former in that the "on" and "off" positions of the switch lever are the reverse of those shown in Figs. 1 and 2. This alteration has been made in order that the direction of movement of the switch lever shall correspond with that of the Circuit-Breakers used in Westinghouse Tramway Equipments.

With the exception of the new Style Nos. given below, all the parts are the same in both old and new switches, so that—with the undermentioned alterations—this Catalogue may be taken to refer to both.


