Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 4th inst.  
with reference to the oil used for the axle boxes of the tram-  
cars on this system.

The Board entered into a contract with Ramsay &  
Treganowan for the supply of their XL Axle Oil at 1/5<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>d. for  
a period of 12 months from the 1st. January last. This oil was  
selected from 11 samples offered, and after tests on the road  
and in the laboratory. Up to now it has been quite satisfactory.

It is our practice not to touch the axle boxes nor  
to oil them, between re-wheeling.

The tenderers claims that this oil is wholly Aus-  
tralian, and this is one of the factors which the Board took  
into account when placing the order.
