An indication that inquiries into the drowning of Ivy Jessie Letitia Russell and her two children, aged three years and 18 months, in the Sunbury swimming pool on June 12, would probably be completed within a week, was given by Sergeant De La Rue at the City Court today.

The husband of the dead woman, Harold James Russell, 26, appeared on a charge of bigamy.

Sergeant De La Rue said that detectives wished to make very exhaustive inquiries, and hoped to complete their inquiries before Friday next.

A remand until July 1 was granted. On the application of Russell, bail was fixed at £200.
