**SUNSHINE TRAGEDY**  
**Husband Charged With Murder**

MELBOURNE, Friday  
Harold James Russell, whose wife and children were found drowned in a creek at Sunshine a fortnight ago, was today charged with the murder of his wife, Ivy Jessie Lettitia Russell, Harold George Russell (3), and Eric Russell (18 months).

Russell, who is alleged to have gone through the form of marriage with Alma Davies, while his first wife was still alive was again remanded by the City Court today on a bigamy charge. Sergeant De La Rue in asking for a remand, said certain developments might occur as the detective on the case wished to make exhaustive inquiries. Russell was granted bail, and afterwards questioned and charged with the murder. He will appear at the court tomorrow.
