DROWNING****Death Of Woman And Two  
Children****TWO CHARGES AGAINST RUSSELL**

MELBOURNE, Friday

Harold James Russell, who has been charged with bigamy, was again remanded for seven days at the City court this morning.

Sergeant de la Haie, in asking for a remand, said that certain developments may occur. He had been informed by detectives in charge of the case that they wished to make some very exhaustive inquiries.

Russell asked for bail, which was granted in two instalments of £100.

Russell's wife and two children were found drowned in the Koroit Brook at Sunshine a fortnight ago. He is alleged to have gone through the form of marriage with Alma Davison while his first wife was alive.

After he had been returned to the cells, Russell was questioned by detectives, and this afternoon he was charged with the murder of his wife, Ivy Jessie Letitia Russell, and her two children, Charles George, aged three, and Eric, aged 18 months, at Sunshine on June 11. He will appear before the City court tomorrow, and will be remanded.
