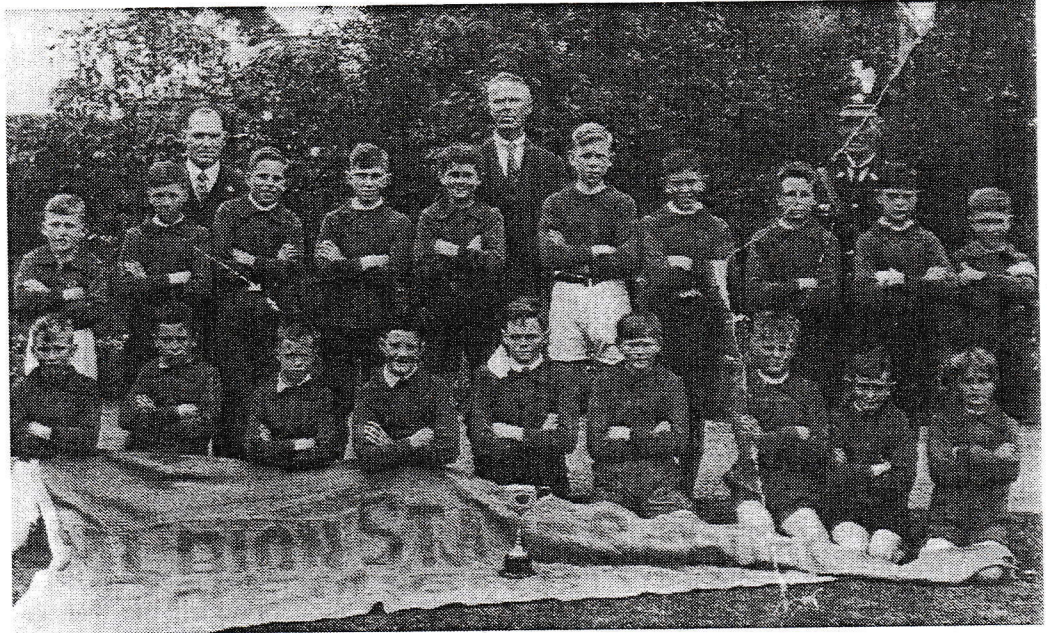


## 1930's
