

DINGY SUNSHINE STATION

PROGRESS ASSOCIATION ASKS FOR IMPROVEMENTS

At the monthly meeting of the Sunshine Progress Association it was decided to ask the Railway Commissioners to clean up and improve the approach to the platform on the Melbourne side, in keeping with the recent improvements effected by the shire council, also to draw their attention to the dingy state of the railway buildings, which urgently require painting.

The association has advised the shire council of their desire to support efforts now being made to secure a larger and more suitable bus between Sunshine and Footscray.

The following suggestion has been forwarded to the traffic conference now sitting in Melbourne: "That a special light, front and rear, be provided on transport motors," and pointing out to the conference that such transports, owing to size and nature of loading, usually retain the centre of the roadway, and a special light would give passing motorists sufficient warning.

The local police authorities have been requested to direct their attention to the "two-up" and betting fraternity on the railway reserve on Saturday afternoons, cricket teams having complained of the nuisance.
