## Played "Two-up"

Three residents of Deer Park, Eric Robinson, Morris Hunter and Lindsay George O'Brien, and Harold Hunter, of 695 Vulmir Parade, Collingwood, were charged at the Sunshine Court this morning with playing an unlawful game, to wit, "two-up." The defendants did not appear.

First-Constable William Shaw stationed at Sunshine, stated that, in company with an auxiliary police officer, he had the four accused under observation at the corner of Station Road and Ballarat Road, Deer Park, at 3.45 p.m. on the afternoon of April 5. They were at the corner, near the store, which was on the main Western Highway, and were in a group throwing coins in the air. When asked for an explanation of their conduct all admitted they were playing for money.

In imposing a fine of 10/- each, the Chairman of the Bench (Mr. W. J. Andrew, J.P.) said the lightness of the penalty should not be taken as guide as to what would be imposed on others who were caught infringing the law, as the Bench would be more severe in the future.
