

**"TWO-UP" PLAYERS FINED.**

At 5.10 p.m. on Friday, 28th inst., Senior Constable Mason, accompanied by First Constable Shaw, were walking along Ballarat Road, near the Braybrook Hotel. They noticed a party of men behind a hoarding and saw a man throw something into the air. Constable Shaw ran forward and observed a man by the name of Ernest Edward Coulson in the act of participation in "Australia's National Game." Another man was bending down and picking up money. In all, the Constable seized 22/-. The name of the man in the stooping position was Alexander Hart. The Constable gave this evidence when Coulson and Hart were charged at Tuesday's Court with playing an illegal game, to wit, two-up.

Both defendants were fined £1 in default 3 days' imprisonment. Coulson did not appear.
