

POLICE RAID HOUSE FOR 'SWY' GAME

OCCUPIER AND PLAYERS FINED

Whilst about 20 men were enjoying a game of two-up, played with dice, at premises situated at 65 Couch St., Sunshine, at 9.15 p.m. on July 16th, gaming police interrupted the proceedings, and as a result William Barnes was charged with the conduct of a gaming house, and John Paine (the occupier) with permitting the premises to be used for gaming purposes.

Each of the accused pleaded guilty at the Sunshine Court on Tuesday last, and Mr. Hammond, P.M., fined Barnes £5 and Paine £10. Time to pay was allowed.

Eighteen men were charged with taking part in the game, and the eleven who answered to their names at the Court were fined 20/, and the seven who did not appear will have to pay 40/- each.
