Treasurer's Report – 2025

Financial Overview

I present the Treasurer's Report for the 2025 season with a brief summary of our financial position. While on-field/court results across 2025 were somewhat positive, our financial outcomes were a little more challenging, particularly in relation to the expanded programs and rising costs across all facets of operations.

The continual strength of the netball program has resulted in a financial loss for that area of the club. The primary cause of this loss was the substantial increase in rental costs for netball facilities, which were considerably higher than originally budgeted. Court hire, training venues, contracted players and the need for additional equipment created an operational cost base that exceeded our revenue from netball alone.

Further financial costs emerged late in the season. The strong performance of all our netball teams resulted in unexpected WRFNL finals-related expenses that had not been factored into the 2025 management fee by league management. This included higher umpire fees, additional operational costs, and extended facility use. While reaching the finals is a fantastic achievement, these unforeseen expenses added to our overall expenditure at a time when the budget was already under strain.

As an Executive, we have set about rectifying this loss for 2025 with tighter guidelines on operation costs, plus substantial increases in netball membership that aligns the senior membership with our football program

Increased Participation and Its Financial Impact

More players require more training sessions, more game-day resources, more medical supplies, additional equipment, and greater facility usage. This has directly contributed to increased rental fees, utility costs (electricity and gas), and general running expenses across the club. The expanded involvement also means greater demand on administration, coaching support, compliance obligations, cleaning and logistics—many of which carry costs when volunteers are unavailable.

Another significant challenge impacting the club financially is the low number of volunteers. With fewer people available to assist across game day, the canteen and bar the club has been forced to pay for more roles and services that were previously volunteer run. This has created an additional financial burden that we will need to manage carefully in 2026. Thank you to the volunteers who assisted when they could.

Financial Focus Areas for 2026

Increased Fundraising Efforts

- The AFL Good for Footy Raffle must become a major focus for the entire club. This raffle has no financial outlay for the club, and we receive the full 100% of the ticket price. Our aim should be to make this the corner stone of our raffles/fundraising program. It takes all members to help to make this program a success, with limited effort.

Netball Program Sustainability

- • Review court hire arrangements and seek alternative options where possible.
- • Assess long-term viability and cost structure of the expanded program.
- • Ensure clearer budgeting for finals-related WRFNL charges.

Rising Operational Costs

- Electricity, gas, waste management and general utilities continue to rise, this will need to be factored and reviewed on an ongoing basis

Financial Planning/Scheduling

- As a club we need to be conservative and thoughtful with our spending, budgeting guidelines need to be rigorous and adhered to. Financial planning and visibility will continue to ensure the long-term financial viability of our club.

Volunteer Engagement

- • Rebuild volunteer numbers across all areas of the club.
- • Reduce reliance on paid roles where possible, as current costs are not sustainable.
- • Create clearer volunteer pathways and expectations to encourage wider member participation.
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I am excited to see what the new year holds. Although I will not be standing for the role of Treasurer in 2026, I look forward to working with the committee, players and supporters to ensure that our club remains a strong foundation of our community. My sincere thanks go to everyone who dedicates their time and effort—often putting the needs of the club ahead of their own health and family. Your commitment is truly appreciated and never goes unnoticed.
