re: Glenroy Improvement Plan

Further to our meeting on the 24th July, 1979 relative to a number of aspects concerning the Shopping Centre, I am enclosing, for the information of your Association, a number of copies of the document "Guidelines for the Future Planning of the Glenroy Shopping Centre and Environs."
