Here is what I have found from a local resident with a great memory:

Madigan – "Just after the war they built a new place out near Brady Road. I think before that they might have lived down Frankston Road near where they had their equipment place. They sold second hand graders and tractors. Liven in Close Avenue and Hampton Park as well."

I think this is a Journal Newspaper item . . . "similarly on Nov 21 1877, P Brady wrote to Dandenong Council asking for opening of road near Stud Road." (Possibly Brady Road of today)
