## DANDENONG WATERWORKS TRUST.

### RATING REGULATIONS.

THAT the Commissioners of the Dandenong Waterworks Trust do hereby, pursuant to and in execution of the powers and authorities conferred by the Water Act 1890, make the following regulation:—

1. The following rates and charges are those which the owners and occupiers of lands and tenements shall pay for the year 1897, in respect of water supply by the Trust within the Trust area, and such rates shall be payable in one moiety on the 23rd December, 1897.

2. On every house and tenement of the annual municipal value of Ten pounds (£10) and under, the annual minimum sum of Twenty shillings (20s) per annum.

3. On every house and tenement above the annual municipal value of Ten pounds sterling (£10), the annual sum of Two shillings in the pound (£1) on the amount of said valuation.

4. Warehouses and wholesale stores not being dwellings or used in retail business, the sum of Two shillings in the pound (£1) on the amount of municipal valuation, provided that in no case shall a less rate than One pound per acre be paid.

5. A rate of Sixpence in the pound (£1) on the amount of valuation of all vacant ground from the 1st of January 1897 to the 31st of December 1897.

6. Water supplied to be used in private domestic premises for domestic or other than domestic use shall be charged at the rate of One shilling (1s) per 1,000 gallons. The minimum quantity to be charged for yearly shall be that which, at One shilling per 1,000 gallons, shall be equal to the amount which the Commissioners would be entitled to receive under the current rating upon the municipal assessed value of any such premises, and at the rate of One shilling per 1,000 gallons for any quantity of water used for the above purposes beyond such an amount as aforesaid.

7. The charge for water supplied for manufacturing and other purposes, and to building, lands, and institutions not rated, to be subject to special agreement with the Trust.

8. For water supplied to charitable institutions for gardens or irrigation purposes, Sixpence per 1,000 gallons.

9. For water supplied to cricket or bowling clubs, subject to arrangement with the Trust.

10. For water supplied to gardens or nurseries cultivated for trade purposes, One shilling per 1,000 gallons.

11. For water supplied to syphon pumps, One shilling per 1,000 gallons, or as may be decided upon by the Commissioners, in addition to a supply for domestic or other purposes.

12. For water supplied to private fountains, Twenty shillings each per annum, or

as may be decided upon by the Commissioners, in addition to a charge for domestic or other purposes.

13. For water supplied and used solely as a motive power for hydraulic lifts, water blasts, turbines, water wheels, electric and other motors (subject to the supply being refused or discontinued at any time), One shilling per 1,000 gallons, or as may be agreed upon, in addition to the rating upon the assessment of the premises for a supply for domestic or other purposes.

14. For a temporary supply during the erection of new buildings, Ten shillings per cent on the amount of contract for stone, brickwork and plastering.

The foregoing regulation was hereby made by the Commissioners of the Dandenong Waterworks Trust on the 21st December, 1897.

### DANDENONG WATERWORKS TRUST.— MINIMUM AMOUNT OF RATES FOR 1897.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the thirty-first day of December, 1897.

WHEREAS by section 102 of the WATER ACT, 1890 (No. 1156) it is enacted that the Governor in Council may from time to time fix a sum which shall be the minimum amount of rates to be paid annually by any owner or occupier of property liable to be rated by any Waterworks Trust: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of the now in part recited Act, doth order and direct that Twenty Shillings (20s) shall be the minimum amount of rates to be paid for the year 1897 by every owner or occupier of any house or tenement liable to be rated by the Dandenong Waterworks Trust under clauses 2 and 4 respectively of its rating regulation for the said year.

And the Honorable Henry Foster, Her Majesty's Minister of Mines and Water Supply for Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
