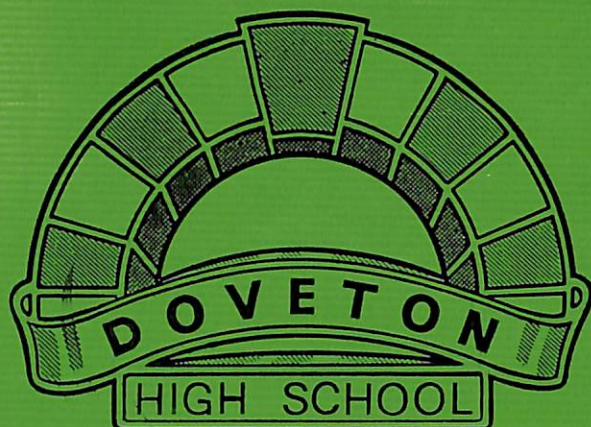

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A Message from the Principal. . .



The 25th anniversary of the school provides a time for reflection, when one can look at the beginnings of the school, its growth, its achievements, its successes, and perchance, its failures. As a teacher of history and as a former teacher at Doveton High School, it has been of interest to me to look at what has changed, and at what has remained much the same over the 25 year life of the school. Have the student body, the teaching staff, the ancillary and maintenance staff, the parent body, the buildings, the grounds and the facilities, the wider school community, changed in the way they interact to provide the best possible learning experiences?

Certainly, the size of the student body has changed greatly over the past 25 years. The numbers in the school grew gradually from its beginning 103 students to over 1100 in the early 1970's to fall to 488 in the early 1980's. There are currently 572 students enrolled at the school. Until the opening of Hallam, Cranbourne and Berwick High Schools in the 1970's, our student body comprised a blend of students with rural and urban backgrounds. Remember the time when no one could be kept in after school because of the buses? By the late 1970's the school body came almost exclusively from the Doveton area. The 1980's have seen the growth in the number of students enrolling from Endeavour Hills, such that these students now comprise of 60 per cent of our current student enrolment. It is likely that this trend will continue. Whatever the origin of our students, and whatever the wider outside community prejudice, our students have, in general, always been ones of whom the school can be proud. Most of our students have valued academic education; they have been prepared to be involved in the wider activities of the school: the sport, music, socials, fund-raising activities; and they have absorbed the values which make for success in the beyond-school world. One may well remember the part played by the prefect body of the late 1960's, for example, when the prefects organized the school socials, the senior-school casserole evenings; the fashion parades and that wonderful "black tie" ball at the Dandenong Town Hall. The S.R.C. and the school musical production of today are the continuing links with these student activities. The cafeteria stands as another beacon of an earlier period of student involvement and activity. The appointment of an integration aide this year highlights another change in the nature of the student body, as the governmental policy of mainstreaming handicapped and disadvantaged students comes into effect. We have three Wheelchair boys, each of whom is making a valuable contribution to the life and understanding of the school.

As student numbers have fluctuated so have staff numbers. The initial teaching staff of five grew to 58 in 1971 and now stands at 47. The school has been fortunate in the calibre of many of the staff appointed to the school. Of the Staff of 1969, for example, 6 became principals, 3 became lecturers in universities or tertiary institutions, at least 4 have been successful in the world outside the Education Department and perhaps the most successful of all, Max Oldmeadow became a member of parliament and later a member of the State Board of Education. Three former members of staff at this school are now principals of private schools. In the middle 1960's

when teacher shortages were at a maximum, the school was fortunate to obtain the services of a most responsible and caring group of teachers, who although untrained as secondary teachers, were able to win the respect and admiration of the students because of their concern and obvious knowledge of the topics they taught. Many of these teachers stayed at the school until their retirement. Many teachers have learned their teaching skills at Doveton High. In 1973 a record number of first-year-out teachers were appointed. This year seven first-year teachers were appointed to the school and already we benefit from their enthusiasm and their infusion of new ideas. However, perhaps the greatest staff changes can be seen in the structure of the school. No longer is there a Senior Master or a Senior Mistress. Level Co-ordinators and Subject Co-ordinators, rather than being promoted appointments to the school are now, by-and-large, staff recommended appointments. A Deputy Principal position was made to the school in 1969. The work of each of these teachers is made easier through the support of the teaching staff but also through the support of the office, the ancillary, the maintenance and cleaning support staff, many of whom have been at the school for a period of in excess of ten years. Did you know Mrs Montague and Mrs Wright still manage the canteen, Miss Willard retires as bursar this year, Mr Baxter is still the head cleaner and Mrs Bell continues to work in the Home Economics department?

It was 20 months before the students of the newly formed Doveton High School moved into their new school buildings. The intervening years have seen great changes to the original buildings. In the 1960's four classrooms were added to the eastern end of the northern wing and the Commonwealth science block to its western wing. Remember, the portables just below where the hall now stands? The hall and the library were the additions in the 1970's during which time much of the land surrounding the school which had been used as playing fields was resumed for building. The 1980's have seen the building of the cafeteria, the land-scaping of the grounds, the painting of the murals, the development of a parent drop-in centre, a dark room, a literacy centre, a computer centre and nearly half a million dollars spent on the internal cyclical maintenance of the school. Gone are the days when senior history classes were taught in the laundry, geography classes taught in the corridors, and science and 9E taught in the portables. Gone also is the Monday assembly in the quadrangle where students saluted the flag and promised to 'cheerfully obey my teachers, parents and the law'.

As with other aspects of the school, so has the curriculum been changed to meet the needs of students, the community, and the demands made by an ever increasing technological knowledge. Mathematics and science remain at the core of the curriculum. English, history and geography have been integrated at Year 7, thereafter to revert to the traditional disciplines. Physical Education and human development have become core subjects. The Art and Craft offerings now include graphics, metalcraft and ceramics — a far cry from woodwork, technical drawing and art of the 1960's. The vertical timetabling of the late 1970's has reverted to a more traditional curriculum organized around Communications, Humanities, Mathematics, Natural & Physical Sciences, Student Development and Creative & Expressive Arts departments. Careers Education is now an important aspect of the curriculum. Whatever the formal curriculum it is still the "extra-curricula" and "hidden" curricula which are the most important. The training in manners; the wearing of a school uniform with pride; the co-operation and sharing (highlighted by the school production); the out-of-school-hours program; the after-school library homework sessions; the Mid-year Program; the S.R.C.; the involvement in the Supplementary Grants and P.E.P. Programs instance these parts of the curriculum. However it is the involvement of the students in school government which perhaps highlights one of the greatest changes in the school. Three students, each with full voting rights, sit on the School Council. A Year 8, a Year 9 and a Year 12 student have been elected to sit with the six parent and five teacher members and the principal. Such a situation could not have been envisaged in the 1960's!

In closing, let me pay two tributes. One is to the parents of the school who have and who continue to support the efforts of the staff and the school Council. Whilst the school has seldom had an active Mothers Club, there was for a time a Parents and Citizens Association and there is now active parent involvement in Supplementary Grants and P.E.P. planning; in the literacy centre; and through the Parent Support Group. The degree of commitment by parents and the community has been a significant feature in the development of the school. Without the perspective and vision of the School Council and particularly the Presidents of the School Council.

The school could not have achieved what it has. My second tribute is to each of the former principals of the school: Mr Wenborn, Mr Johnson, Mr Thompson, Mr Adams and Mr Blood. Each has left his mark on the school, fostering those things seen as worthwhile, changing and adapting that which will make for a better learning environment for our students. Without their vision, their determination, their dedication and commitment to children, and their wisdom, Doveton High School would be a poorer place in which to educate and in which to be educated.

HISTORY OF THE SCHOOL



Doveton High School began in the Scots Church Hall, Dandenong on the 3rd February, 1960, with 103 Form I pupils and 5 teachers. Of these pupils, approximately half came from Doveton, while the remainder came from the surrounding rural areas of Hallam, Narre Warren, Berwick, Beaconsfield, Cranbourne and Clyde. Over the early years the pattern of school population remained fairly constant maintaining an even balance between suburban and country pupils. The first Head-Master of the school was Mr L. P. Wenborn.

Doveton High School's growth rate was typical of high schools established in the outer-metropolitan areas of post World War II years. Enrolment figures showed a steady rate of increase rising from 103 in 1960 to peak at over 1100 in 1971.

The rapid growth of the outer metropolitan area saw the establishment of Cranbourne High School, Hallam High School and Berwick High School. These schools took the pressure off Doveton's intake, and from 1972, Doveton High School began to experience a decline in enrolments, so that by 1982, student enrolment was just below 500. The gradual ageing of the settled Doveton population and the addition of other "local" high schools had taken their toll.

Student numbers are now slowly increasing again, due largely to the ever-expanding housing development in Endeavour Hills, (Chalcott Lodge, and Mossgiel Park) areas.

THE FIRST FIVE YEARS

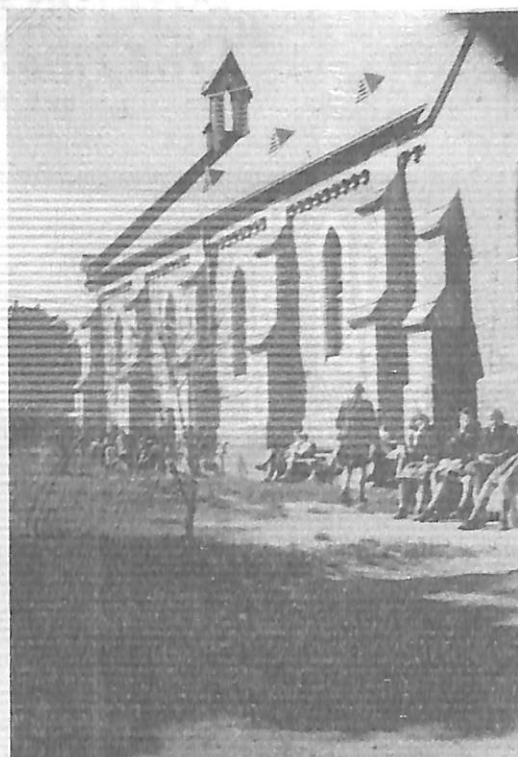
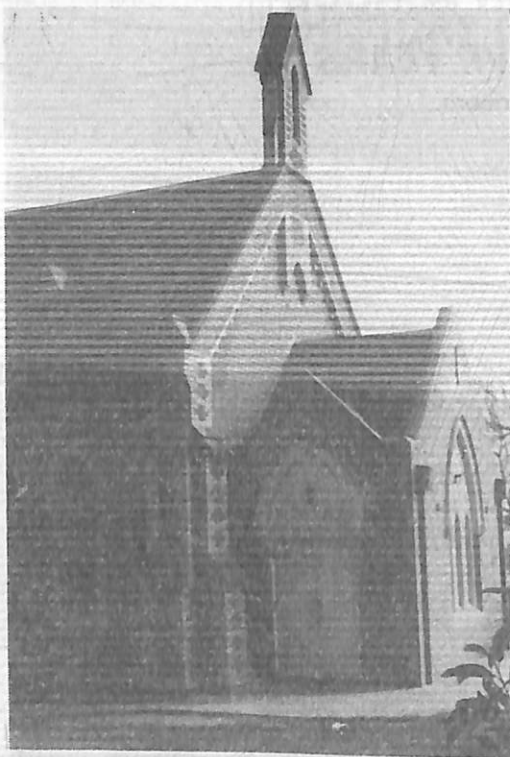

The phenomenal growth of the High School system in the '50's and '60's uncovered an acute shortage of suitable temporary accommodation, but with the help of stackable furniture, demountable screens, eager pupils and long suffering teachers the business of education was pursued day by day with commendable drive. Perhaps those students who triumphed over such adversity deserve to be honoured the more. In fact I would thoroughly enjoy reading separately about success stories of ex-Doveton High School scholars.

During 1959, the Education Department decided that a new High School should be established in the Doveton area, then the centre of a new migrant population. Such a school would help to release pressure of numbers at both Dandenong High School and Dandenong Girls School. A year later another High School began at Lyndale nearby. Therefore, the District Inspector was obliged to seek a likely building. He came upon Dandenong Presbyterian Church, which boasted not only a Sunday School Hall, but also an adjoining Scout Hall, which after due negotiation became the birth place of Doveton High School. With caneite partitions these spaces were converted into four classrooms, and as quickly demounted to leave the area free for use, by night and at weekends, for Church functions. Poor kids, as each day neared completion, the dreary job of collapsing classrooms was thrust upon them, and each morning it was one group's task to "set up shop". Unbelievable nowadays, is such a picnic, but circumstances demanded it so everyone put up with it. If there were complaints, I have forgotten them, what I do recall is that the spirit engendered among those 100 first form pupils had to be experienced, to be understood. It should be mentioned too, that the Principal with his office clerk, occupied the choir vestry!

I remember that some parents were at first a little concerned that their children were denied access to an established school. Elder brothers and sisters may have attended the schools in Dandenong. What parents soon realized was that Doveton High School aimed to build a tradition of its own, based on good teacher-pupil understanding, with emphasis on scholarship and good social behaviour. I hope Doveton High School succeeded. We found good leaders among our youngsters and gave them scope to exercise common sense. We had a mixture of European nationalities, mainly British, German, Italian. Some parents found great difficulty with the English language, but their children were quick to learn and often became teachers to the parents.



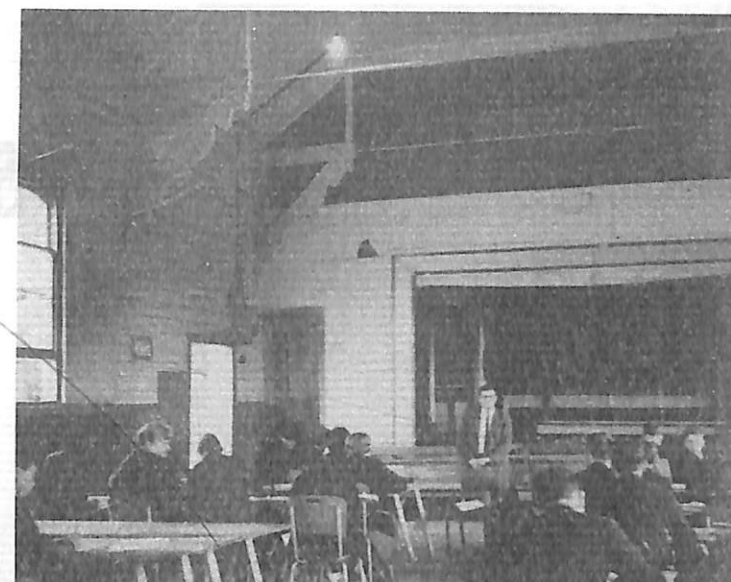
One morning, I asked an Italian lad to bid me good morning in his native tongue. I doubt whether he remembers the occasion I certainly do for his "Buon Giorno" really impressed me. My pleasure from his greeting still abides.

When it became obvious that there was no chance of the new building in Power Road being completed before school reopened in 1961, the Principal was directed to obtain extra accommodation needed to house at least twice the 1960 numbers. The C. of E. parish hall was hired as well as a sports pavilion some three quarters of a mile distant, beside the local cricket field. The latter building added to our problems in time-tabling because interchange of classes was possible only at the mid-day recess. But at least the pavilion had one major advantage — no competition with another class hard by. And perhaps another, being remote from H.Q. at the Presbyterian Church!

Naturally, supply of teaching aids had to be limited because of lack of storage space. For example, a science room or any specialist room for that matter requires all sorts of gear. Where to put it all, at the end of the day? Departmental cupboards were provided when they could be housed but teachers needed a considerable degree of initiative to cope with unusual and sometimes aggravating problems. As ever it was the resourceful teacher who achieved most.

By the end of year 2, with over 200 on the roll, Doveton High School was bursting to claim a building of its own, now almost ready in Power Road, Doveton North. We escaped from Dandenong just prior to the Christmas vacation in December 1961, anticipating 1962 as a year full of promise in smart new premises with all pupils under one roof, specialist rooms, staff rooms, and SPACE in which to breathe anew. After two years of congestion and inconvenience, what a thrill it was for pupils and teachers alike. I have little recollection of the attendant changeover arrangements, but certainly the first School day of 1962 was a memorable occasion.

A word about the school bus system is opportune. Grenda's Buses secured most of the contracts and the firm proved very co-operative. Control of bus services was exercised from H.Q. in Melbourne with the aid of 'on the spot' advice from local Principals. It became departmental policy to "award" the high school principal the job of maintaining these services so that all districts gained similar opportunity for bus travel. A complicated procedure, to be sure. One can readily understand how delighted was the Principal of Dandenong High School to be relieved of such a job! I wonder how the bus problem is attacked nowadays? I fondly imagine that the matter is now handled by a competent transport facility.



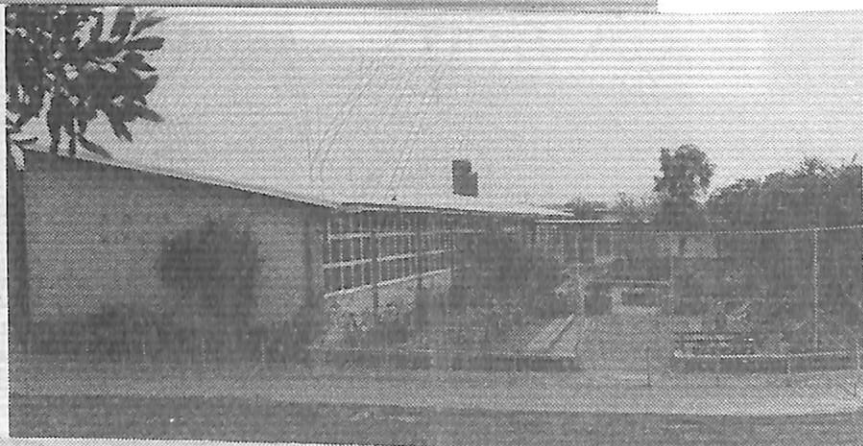
At this point the proposed Mulgrave freeway extension was designed to cut through N.E. corner of the school property in its approach to W. Gippsland. We argued that reduction below the minimum 12 acres for a Secondary School was out of the question, and I recall consultation with the then Surveyor General whose office adjoined the department in Treasury Place. With his cheerful advice we were better able to meet the situation which resulted in the addition of land for Doveton High School to compensate for loss of part of the N.E. corner. I do not think we gained much space, but at least we could see a way of improving the movement of School buses on the S.E. angle.

After five years of growth, attendance exceeded 600, enough to raise the status of the school to Special Class, and I recall that this total was well in excess of the 50 year-old Warrnambool High School, to which I was promoted in 1965. Now that Doveton High School has attained 25 years of age I offer my congratulations to those who guided its destiny from the beginning of its sixth year. May the ensuing twenty-five years be as personally rewarding for the pupils and staff as were the first 5 exciting years when the contribution by members of staff was outstanding. Many of them were subsequently attracted to brother institutions within their careers have been watched with admiration.

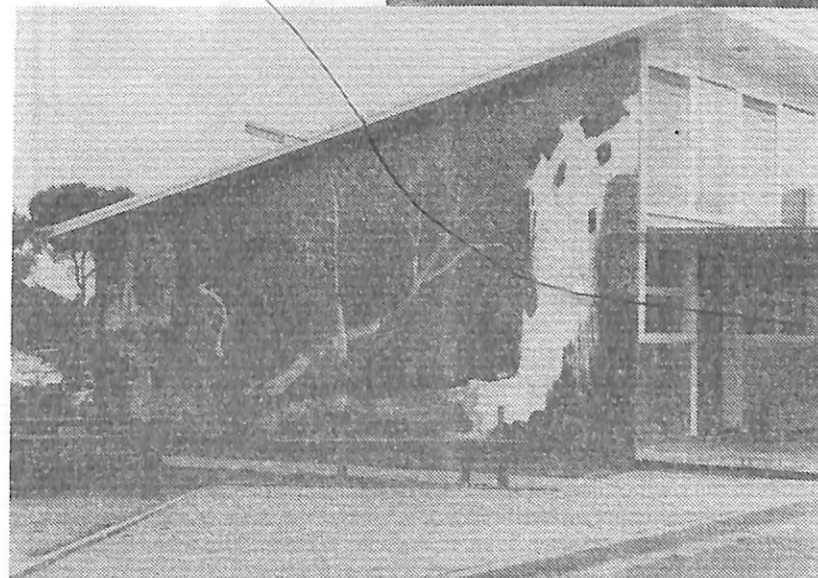
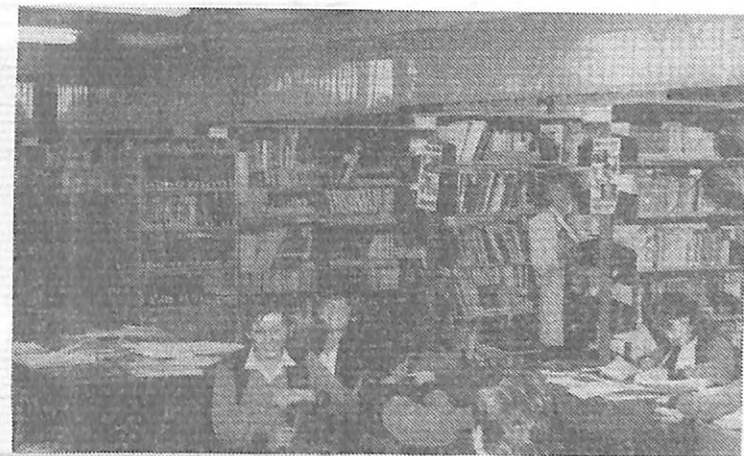

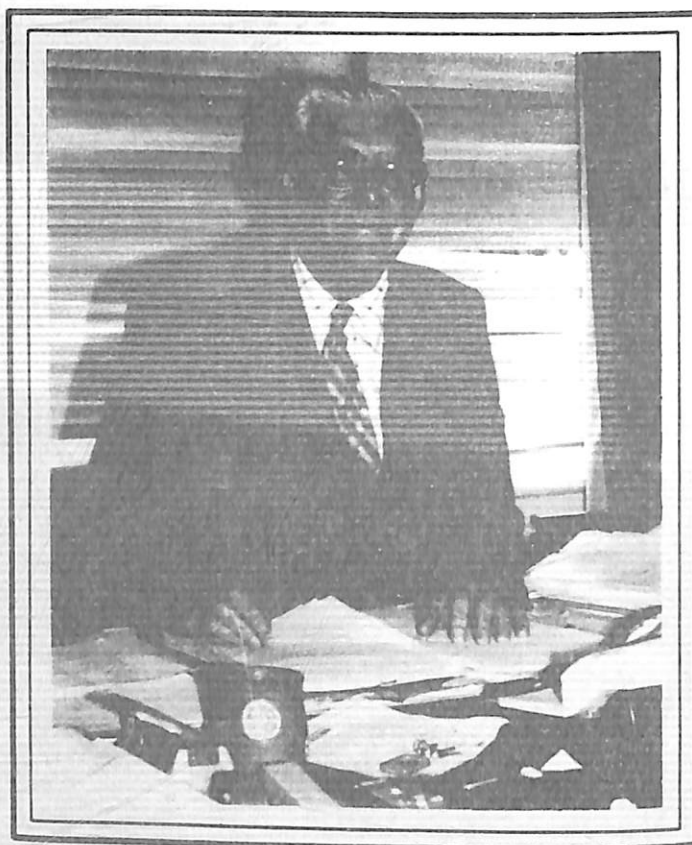

THE EXPERIMENTAL YEARS

1977 - 1982

INTRODUCTION

I think I would describe the years of my Principalship at Doveton High as 'The Experimental Years'. There were two aspects of my own philosophy of Principalship which made it easy for me to accept a certain amount of experimentation. First, I did not see the Principal as the fount of all Knowledge but as the leader of a team whose task it was to assess the strengths and capabilities of his highly trained staff and channel these where they would best be used. Second, I believed there were often a number of correct ways of accomplishing many tasks and that the one that I would use may not necessarily be the one that others have to use.

TAKING UP MY APPOINTMENT

Because my appointment to Doveton was made late in 1976 I had only a few brief opportunities to talk with my predecessor, Mr Bill Thompson. He wisely, I believe, made a few explicit judgements leaving me to find out for myself what this reputedly difficult school was really like. I spent the week before school began planning the organization for the opening of the new school year with Deputy Principal Mr John Hobba and Senior Master Mr Peter Ward. I soon became aware of the first of the experiments.

EXPERIMENT 1. THE VERTICAL TIMETABLE

It had been agreed the previous year that a vertical timetable should be introduced. The idea was to do away with the 'artificial' horizontal set up of forms and subjects according to age and year at school and to create a vertical one in which a pupil of any age could take any subject at any level. For example, English would be time-tabled at all levels at the same time enabling any student, whatever his age, to take any level. Form groups were no longer based on age levels but each group would contain a mixture of ages from 11 to 16 years old. One advantage was that students who were either slower or faster than their age levels at a particular subject could do a higher or lower standard than their peers. It was felt that a large number of Doveton students would be advantaged socially and intellectually by such a system. The difficulties of time tabling this structure were considerable but it was achieved by the Senior Master with the help of a small committee. A vertically structured school was working well at Healesville, from where Doveton's inspiration came, and several other schools, but it never achieved the hoped-for success at Doveton High.

DIFFICULTIES

(a) One problem was keeping track of students who would split up into different classes for every other lesson after the initial group assembly at the beginning of the day. Eventually masses of class lists appeared by which teachers could check the presence of pupils. It was an immense task keeping these lists up to date and wiley students (and there were sufficient of these to be of concern) soon learned to play the system.

(b) Another difficulty was the wide range of ages in some classes which caused some social problems for some teachers. At the time Doveton High seemed to have more than its fair share of new and inexperienced teachers who had to learn the art of class control and of building up a satisfactory rapport with students. To have the added burden of applying a new and strange timetable made their task all the more difficult.

(c) There was also, it is fair to say, a significant number of teachers who were opposed in varying degrees to such a radically different organization.

We persisted with the vertical timetable for several years but gradually returned to the more conventional horizontal form and classes by age level structure until by the time I left no trace of it remained.

EXPERIMENT 2. ALTERNATE CLASSES

While the vertical experiment dominated the first half of my time, in the latter half we tried another way of assisting those who were either low in achievement for one reason or another or low in self esteem. This experiment, however, only affected a small class size group of students, not the whole school as did the vertical timetable. The Alternate classes developed around Work Experience and had a session of this each term and a special curriculum which was closely connected to it. They had their own special area in the school and under the guidance of Ms. Marj Munro obtained special grants from Commonwealth funds to finance a special communications set-up, a gardening project, a motor mechanics course and a Research Assistant to help with the organization. Unfortunately when Ms. Munro took up another appointment the scheme faded away.

INSTABILITY

Like the vertical structure, the Alternate Classes had many worthwhile possibilities but the difficulties in applying such schemes without special consideration being given for extra staffing and financial assistance were just too much for the school to withstand. The very word 'experiment' implies a certain amount of instability and there was a considerable amount of this during my time. But it did not only come from the experiments. Some if it was due to factionalism that existed among the staff and which was by no means peculiar to Doveton High. There was a strong Victorian Secondary Teachers Association branch which not only gave support to state wide matters but quite often took issue with me on internal matters of organization and working conditions. So, from time to time, the bulk of the school would be closed for a half day or a day when the VSTA members held their stop-work meeting. As well there were deep differences of opinion over teaching philosophies which permeated the school and were picked up by outsiders who sometimes misinterpreted the true situation and over reacted and the school's name tended to suffer.

EXPERIMENT 3. SCHOOL UNIFORM

In 1978 some of the members of staff on School Council who were keen for a change in regards to school uniform conducted a survey among staff, students and parents. Should we have a uniform, should it be optional or compulsory? My recollection is that a majority of students were keen to do away with uniform, staff were fairly evenly divided, while the few parents who responded preferred uniform. The issue climaxed with a motion before School Council making uniform optional which was passed by a small majority. I viewed this as a legitimate exercise of Council authority and for the remainder of my time uniform became optional. Some students continued to wear it but most didn't. Nevertheless we attempted to instil a pride in appearance and did not tolerate untidy or slovenly dress.

But there remained a persistent minority among staff and students who wished to return to a compulsory uniform. Parents were strongly in favour. We did introduce an attractive maroon jumper with a newly designed school emblem which became a popular item of dress.

A SCHOOL REVIEW

As I neared the time of my retirement I was keen that there should be a School Review which would give an objective view of the state of the school and could make recommendations or suggestions (e.g. about school uniform) which would assist my successor. In consequence we set about organizing one early in 1981. The actual Review, we planned, would take place early in 1982 when some dozen experts would spend a week thoroughly investigating the school. But for the staff and the school the really hard work took place during the preceding twelve months. All staff and some students and School Councillors were formed into Committees which together produced an Internal Review report which told what we thought the school was like and this was the basis on which the External Review members worked. Their visit in March 1982 was almost a pleasurable respite for staff and committees who had put so much extra work into the previous twelve months. Both Internal and External Review reports are available in the school and show that Doveton High had much to commend it in those years.

A DECREASING SCHOOL POPULATION

In 1971 there were over 1100 students in the school but when I arrived in 1977 there were below 700 and by 1982 it had dropped to below 500. Originally Doveton had received pupils from as far away as the Cranbourne and Berwick areas, but with the construction of new schools, particularly Hallam High, a rapid drop in enrolment occurred.

This might have been offset to some degree by pupils from the rapidly expanding Endeavour Hills area but there was an unfortunate resistance from some parents there who considered Doveton High unsatisfactory for their children. I disciplined, tough, rough, no uniform, no language taught were some of the reasons given. The Regional Director was opposed to strict zoning and this enabled a considerable number of each year's new intake to go to other schools. I requested that all dissenting parents should visit the school and see for themselves but only a few game ones did so.

The drop in school numbers had both good and bad results. In my time we never had any accommodation problem such as most other schools had. There were always spare rooms and we made the most of the situation. The Band had a fine room to itself as did Drama and other specialized subjects. Even when we hosted the new Cranbourne Meadows Technical School for one term in 1981 while its new buildings were being constructed we were able to manage reasonably well.

But an unfortunate result of the drop in population was that we had to curtail the number of HSC subjects offered. This meant that some of our very promising students had to go to other schools to complete their education. In 1981 and 1982 we shared some HSC subjects with Hallam and Berwick Highs in an endeavour to broaden the range offered but this meant more travelling for the students.

EXPERIMENT 4. LETTING THE HALL

The hall had been rarely let out to the public before my time but I felt there was a good opportunity here to increase our very restricted financial resources. The Canteen had been the only source of extra money beyond the Departmental Grant and this money was used to pay off the Hall Cooperative. So we rather tentatively began to let the hall to various organizations and gradually worked up our own very satisfactory clientele. In my last years we let the hall every night of the week and Saturday and Sunday. We had to eventually keep it free on Fridays so that proper maintenance could be done. It was fortunate that we developed this source of income because our canteen (along with most other school canteens) found that rising costs made it difficult to even square the books each year let alone have a surplus.

I hasten to add that but for the outstanding general supervision of the hall letting by caretakers Mr and Mrs Baxter it would not have been possible to so satisfactorily carry out this project.

EXPERIMENT 5. THE NEW-LOOK SCHOOL COUNCIL

It was during my time that the School Council became more widely representative of the whole school (with staff and student representatives) and was required to accept greater responsibilities. Its main project under way before 1977 was the levelling and draining of the school oval in cooperation with Berwick City Council. Since then it carried out a number of projects of which three were particularly successful. It supported the formation of the school Concert Band and helped with the purchase of the Band's fine set of instruments. Then, after a great deal of hard work and sweat by Council members, the dull gravelled area east of the art wing was transformed into an attractive and busy paved rest area. The Student's Cafeteria, a project carried through by a Council Committee headed by teacher Councillor Glenn Werkmeister, was a fitting culmination of Council's work in my time.

SCHOOL COUNCIL

In 1974, together with other parents I was a member of the Doveton High School Advisory Committee. Later, after the changing of the Education Act, the composition was changed to 7 parents, 6 staff, and 2 students, and it was to be called the Doveton High School Council.

In its initial year I was elected Treasurer, and in the second year the Constitution of School Councils was changed to prevent staff from holding the President's chair. I then became President of the School Council, and continued to hold that office until 1980.

Highlights during those six years were the formation of the school orchestra, the opening of the Careers Room, the leasing of the Assembly Hall to outside groups, the joint use of the sports ovals with the Berwick City Council, the upgrading of the tennis courts, and the introduction of green and black P.E. uniforms which became the basis of the current school uniform.

My experience in the School Council was certainly useful when I was elected to Berwick City Council.

In celebrating your 25 years, as Mayor of the City of Berwick, I wish Doveton High School, the students, the staff, and the parents all good wishes for the future. I feel proud to be a part of the School's past, and look forward to its good future.

PREFECTS

This was the pledge made by the Prefects of the School. Prefects were in either Year 11 or 12. They were elected by the student body to act as intermediaries between the staff and students. The Prefects were responsible for the organization of and supervision of student activities. They presented student views to staff and they represented the school at official occasions.

From the Prefect body, two Head Prefects were chosen or elected, one boy and one girl. Head Prefect was the highest honour that could be bestowed on a student.

In 1974 the office of Prefect was abolished. This was in keeping with the philosophy of the time.

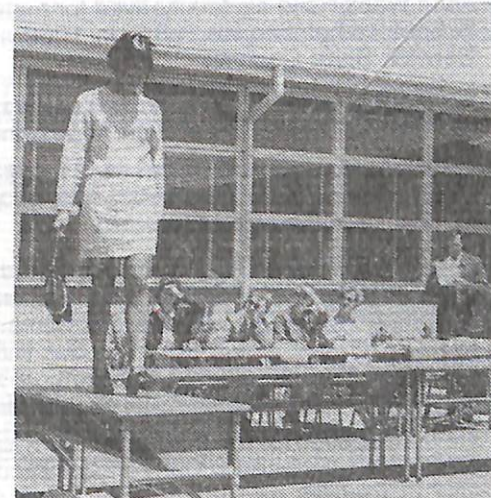
Students Raise Money for Charity

During the year approximately \$700 has been raised by Doveton High students to be distributed to needy causes in the area - quite a remarkable achievement.

The methods of raising the money have varied from straightforward donation to the staging of lunch hour concerts and food stalls, with some unusual attractions, including washing of staff cars, a mannequin parade, a hula hoop competition, and fortune telling. Such activities often provided enjoyment for those taking part of course, but there was often some rehearsal and organisation involved which called for considerable sacrifice and hard work from those concerned.

The money will be distributed mainly to aged people and needy children in Doveton and outlying areas, and will include the following institutions:

The school instrumental music programme which began in 3rd term 1976 has now grown to the stage where we have a woodwind/brass/and percussion band comprising 30 students.

This year we have been most fortunate to obtain the services of two itinerant instrumental teachers; Miss Megan Crocker who teaches woodwind instruments, and Mr. Tony Webber, who teaches brass instruments. Students receive one twenty-five minutes lesson per week and are withdrawn from normal lessons on a rotating timetable basis so that students do not miss the same subject each week.

The school is also most fortunate to have received about \$8500 of orchestral instruments from a special Education Department Grant. These instruments will remain in the school for three years before being given to another school. It is hoped that Doveton High School will raise the above-mentioned amount of money in the next three years to replace these instruments.

Instruments being taught at Doveton High School include flute, clarinet, oboe, bass clarinet, bassoon, alto and tenor saxophone, trombone, trumpet, french horn, tuba, euphonium, tenor horn and drums.

Two of our students, Christine O'Donnell and Grant Coulter sat for A.M.E.B. exams in flute, clarinet and theory of music, and we are happy to say that both received honours in all subjects.

Students are encouraged to purchase their own instruments when it has become obvious that they will continue, but most students hire instruments from the school.

A CAREER PATHWAY

John Walker and his family, lived for many years in Doveton. He attended Doveton High School, completing his H.S.C. in 1968 and while waiting for his results he worked for Berwick Shire Council.

He thought he would be a teacher and was granted a teaching studentship. Off he went to Monash University full of high hopes and ambitions.

Luckily, a teacher at Doveton High had suggested a career in local government. Luckily, because John hated university and failed his first year. So? What to do? (A question familiar to many school leavers.)

This is when his career path really started going somewhere. He got a job at Nunawading City Council as an Administrative Officer and studied local government by correspondence through R.M.I.T. (Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology). He gained a Municipal Clerk's Certificate and moved to Box Hill Municipal Council, as a senior Administrative Officer, at the ripe old age of twenty. John continued to study doing three subjects per year by correspondence until he was twenty-three years old.

He then applied for the position of Shire Secretary of the Upper Murray Valley Shire Council and was stationed at Corryong for about three years from whence he came back to the City of Prahran as Deputy Town Clerk (now about twenty seven years old) for three years.

At this time, John went to Canberra on Local Government Course where he heard of, and applied for, the position of Deputy Town Clerk at the City of Perth along with forty other applicants. He got the job and is earning about \$46,000 per year, currently, getting about \$60,000 per year when he takes over the Town Clerk's duties from time to time.

His parents tell me he is very proud of coming from Doveton and of his school, Doveton High School.

WHAT'S IT LIKE NOW?

All levels are on a Semester (half-yearly) system with reports being issued twice a year.

Level 7 have a home teacher for 12 periods per week with a subject called Integrated Studies.

At level 10, students have two weeks of work experience, and they choose courses to suit their careers.

We have exams at Levels 11 and 12 (HSC), with level 12 exams set by VISE. Many subjects at year 12 have about 30% of their marks decided by their teacher.

The Mid-Year Program is a two-week program of extra-curricular activities between semesters designed to give students a chance to study various topics of interest.

The school has a Careers teacher, and instead of a Pupil Welfare Co-ordinator, we have Level Co-ordinators for each level.

There are two major events now for House Competition, and they are swimming and athletics. Inter-school sports for summer and winter competition are played against Dandenong, Lyndale and Cleeland H.S.

Students have their own S.R.C., and there are now three elected student representatives on School Council.

Uniforms have been re-introduced, and the jackets are green and black. Ties are not required.

We have a Parent Drop-In Centre and a Literacy Centre for junior levels. These were sponsored mainly through Supplementary Grants. Camps and the acquisition of computers have also been funded through these grants.
