

THE BEGINNING OF DANDENONG'S CLUB

Dandenong Club has purchased a substantial property on McCrae St. containing the large brick house pictured here which is to form the nucleus of its Club premises. The plans, drawn up by a Melbourne architect, provide for reading, writing, and card rooms, a lounge-bar, billiard room, cloak rooms, a toilet and kitchen. The spacious grounds will be laid out to include a bowling green, tennis court, squash court, and off-street parking for 75 cars.

The Club is registered as a non-profit-making company, and registration as licensed premises is being sought.

We understand the object of the club is to provide a comfortable club where men may meet for social, business, and recreational purposes.
