

LEFT:

View of Buhler Press from front left, showing web going over former into folding box and out on fly.

Rotary Stop Press unit is at centre top, but in this case is not operating.

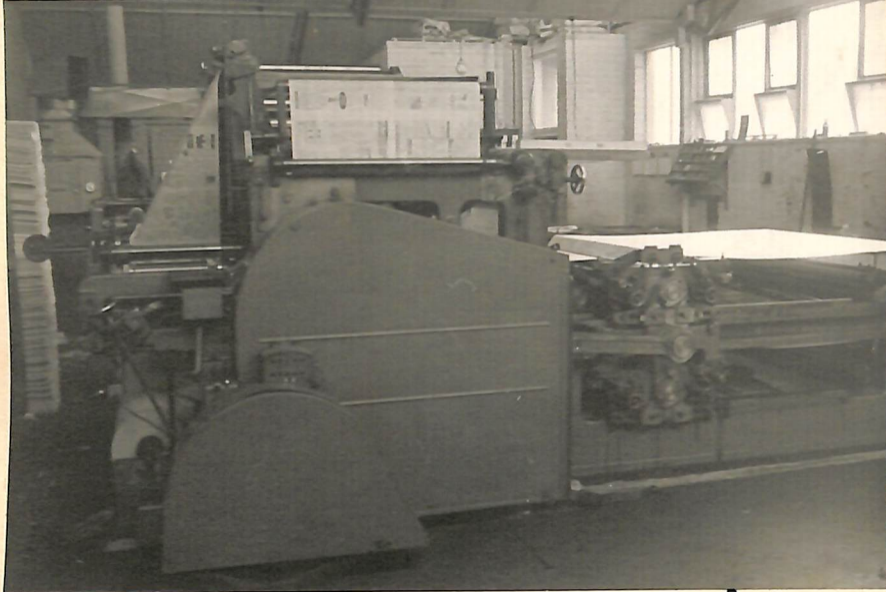
Table at bottom left is used for temporary forme storage and main interleaving.

RIGHT:

Main interleaving table at side of Press. Table carries two interleavers, working off fly, and two bumpers who also transfer previously interleaved sections from stack at extreme right to the table.

The web can be seen running through the rotary Stop Press unit behind the interleaver at extreme left.





LEFT:

Right profile of Press shows web running from reel at lower front, along lower deck, up through return rollers at end, back across top deck, through transport rollers, over and down former into folding box.

Pre-printed sections of issue are piled against side wall at extreme left.

RIGHT:

Right profile of Press at oblique angle.

Return path of web across top deck and up through transport rollers can be clearly seen.

At rear of Press and at top right are the main make-up stones.
