Hotel revamp welcomed

ACCOMMODATION in Dandenong took another step forward recently when Quest Dandenong unveiled a \$1.3 million refurbishment.

Quest Dandenong property manager Nick Ritchie said the four-month redevelopment would have a big impact.

tion of central Dandenong", while Greater Dandenong Mayor Heang Tak said the city's economic future was "dependent on the infrastructure, skills and vibrancy of our region".
