New hotel makes its reservation with \$25m

A \$25 MILLION hotel is taking shape in central Dandenong.

The Quest Dandenong Central development at 2-10 Walker Street is part of the \$290 million Revitalising Central Dandenong initiative.

At a site inspection on Thursday 19 November were Dandenong MP Gabri-

elle Williams, Quest CEO Zed Sanjana, Pellicano managing director Nando Pellicano and Places Victoria representatives.

Mr Sanjana said domestic overnight expenditure for business tourism in the state increased by 21 per cent in the year to June compared to the previous period.

"Within the same period, international overnight expenditure also grew," he said.

Ms Williams said business tourism and investment were keys to Dandenong's growth and rejuvenation.

"This development by Quest Apartment Hotels is another significant step in the continued improvement of Central

Dandenong," she said.

Quest Dandenong Central will feature 95 apartments in studio, one, two and three bedroom configurations, plus on-site parking, a conference room and gymnasium.

The property is expected to open in August next year.
