Dandenong District Road Board Official Minutes

10 March 1866

From Mr ^{Matthew} Harvey asking the Board to erect a check toll gate near Bergin & Broadhurst's paddocks so as to prevent evasion (to be inspected anyway)

24 March

From Messrs Phillips & Gayer asking permission to remove some gum trees on the Brighton Rd near the Mile Creek - application refused

The engineers reported that Mr Leonard had fenced across the Mornington Rd leaving sliprails, which was an obstruction to traffic.

Mr Henry Jones' letter referring to his contract on the Mornington Rd was considered & the Clerk informed the Board that he had received a summons for the County Court which claimed £49. Bowman - Goffe: agreed to defend the action and that the claimant & clerk employ counsel and take the necessary steps required.
