Topic: two photos of c.1920s H. Green and Co's Dandenong Drapery Staff - originally contained in a collection in the possession of Ted and Shirley Rotherham, members of the Warrandyte Historical Society.

Mr.Rotherham wishes to donate these photographs to the Dandenong Historical Society. Although he apparently has attempted to contact your Society by phone a number of times, he tells me regrettably that has been unable to

make contact. He has passed the photos onto me, thinking I might have better luck in contacting you by email.

Ted Rotherham's family has for decades had in its possession these two mounted photographs of H. Green and Co. staff personnel standing outside their Dandenong drapery premises during the early 1920s.

EVREY

Featured in both photos is Miss Maude ~~Evrey~~, who was to become Mrs Rotherham and Ted's mother. A tall lady, she is pictured in the first photo (~~gray~~ <sup>four</sup> Mount) - i.e., a close up of five adults - where she is standing on the right hand side. In the second photo (~~four~~ <sup>five</sup> mount), which was taken from a distance, she is the fifth person standing from the car on the left and next to the verandah post, near the centre, where she can be seen holding a Union Jack. - the taller of the two ladies holding such flags.

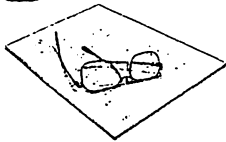

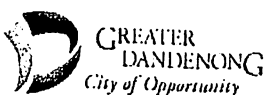
