Company's move a coup for economy

A DRIED fruit distribution centre in Dandenong South says it has planted the seed for 25 new jobs.

Murray River Organics has revamped its packaging facility at Crompton Way and made the site its new headquarters.

The business sells dried

fruit, grain and nuts all over the world. They moved into their packaging plant at Dandenong South at the end of last year and recently finished the \$4.5 million fit-out.

Murray River Organics managing director Erling Sorensen said they will soon increase their workforce from 50 full-time staff to 75.

He said they chose to relo-

cate their head office from Melbourne's CBD to Dandenong South because it was seen as a strategic base.

State Minister for industry and employment Wade Noonan said having the site in Dandenong South was "another vote of confidence in our economy and workforce and great for jobs in Melbourne's southeast".
