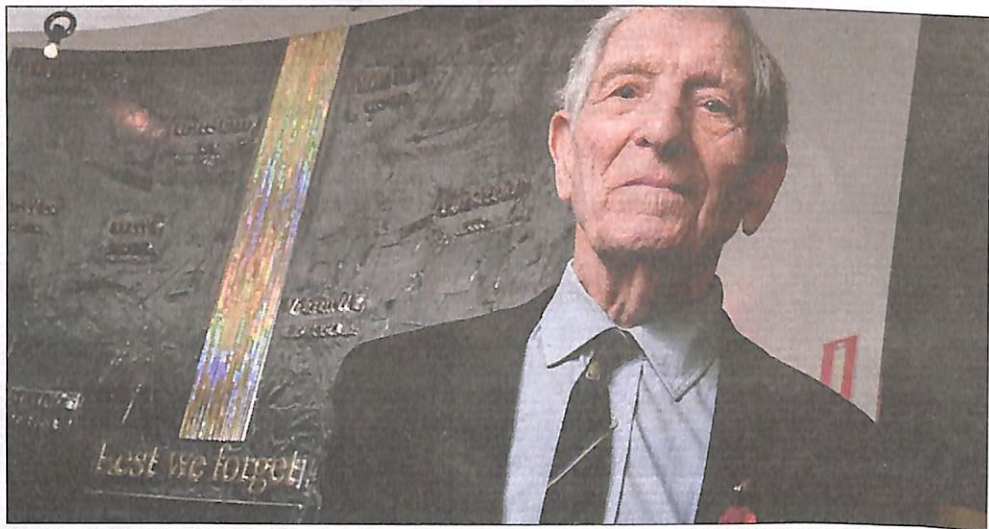

Reflection and remembrance

ON Remembrance Day, Dandenong-Cranbourne RSL sub branch will hold services at Greg Clydesdale Square, Hight St and Pillars of Freedom, Clow St at 11am.

Later in the day, a concert promoting peace will be held in Dandenong.

Organiser Geraldine Gonsalvez said the 'Centenary Armistice Poppy Day Peace Concert' would "revisit the spirit of the Armistice in a

celebration of peace and the termination of all the hostilities of World War 1".

"The concert is a not for profit voluntary effort that was an innovation of the Friends of Rowan Park House since its inaugural peace concert hosted in the centenary of World War One in 2014," she said.

"It's a celebration of the concept of peace at a global and local level within our homes and our wider communities."

She urged patrons to attend as a way of celebrating peace and marking Remembrance Day.

Ms Gonsalvez noted the November 11 concert coincided with the 100th anniversary of the signing of the Armistice on November 11, 1918.

The concert will be held at The Drum Theatre, Dandenong, on Sunday, November 11, at 6.30pm.

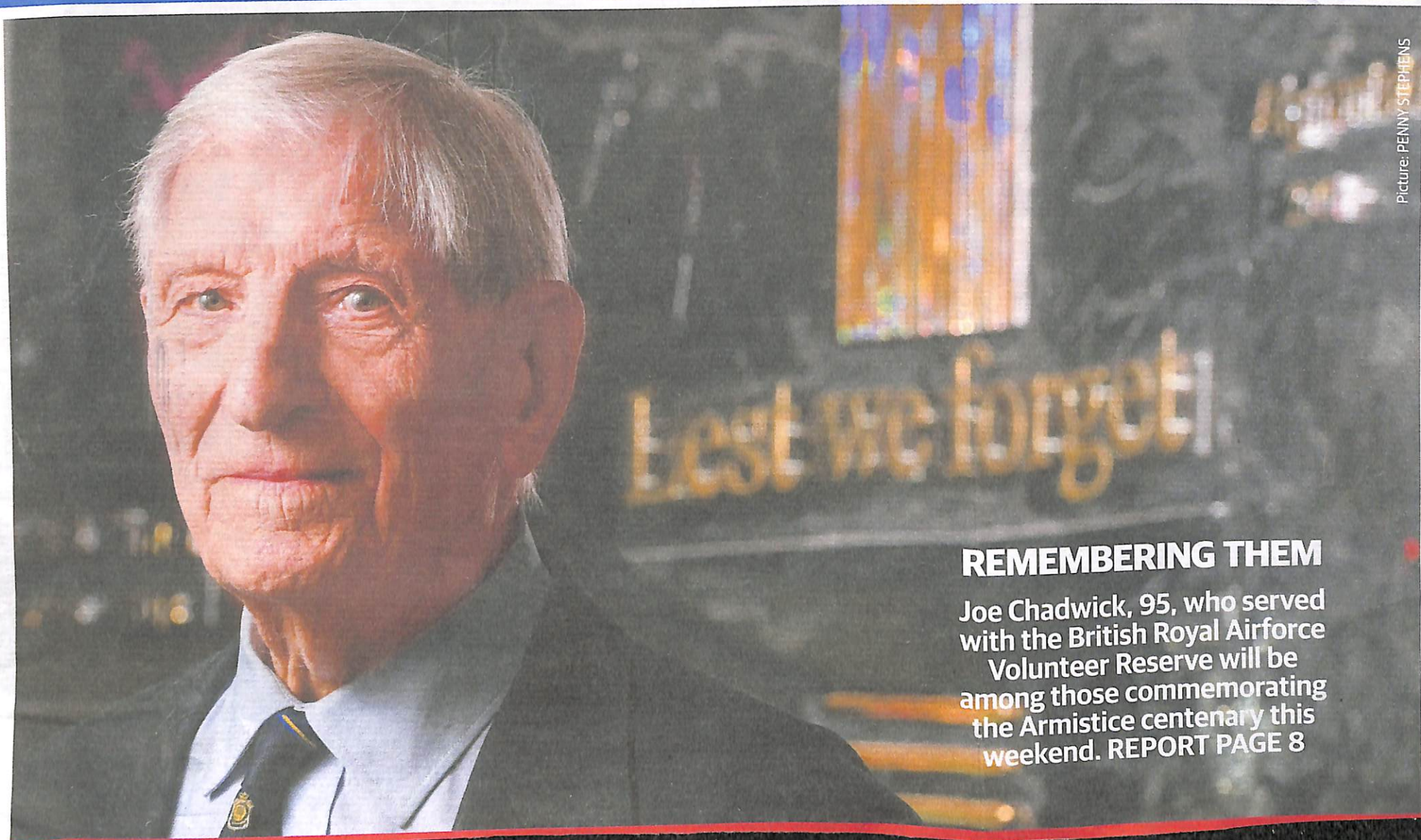
