Rex has been 26 years in the fibrous plaster industry. He did his apprenticeship in Dandenong and during that period he attended Prahran Technical College and gained a proficiency certificate in the trade from the Fibrous Plaster Manufacturers' Association.

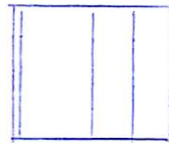
He then spent a number of years with a city company to further his practical knowledge and in 1932 established his own business, with his wife as a partner, in Heatherlon Rd., Noble Park.

He had the opportunity of purchasing a property with an existing fibrous plaster factory on Princes Hwy. in 1969 and after modernising the premises he began manufacturing fibrous plaster and plaster board in a large variety of designs, by the improved method.

Rex also specialises in suspended ceiling work, acoustic treatment and insulation using Bradford Insulation and Insulwool Fibreglass for both domestic and commercial jobs.

He employs a staff of 11 including three apprentices, one of whom, Don Santoni, won the top award presented by the Fibrous Plaster Manufacturers' Association, and was runner-up in the CSR award.

Rex has purposely limited the size of the business to maintain his personalised service to the building trade and home builder.
