Jenny recently spoke to *MINUTE FOR MISSION*. "I work with the presbyteries and parishes of the church, creating opportunities for lay education for ministry."

"Lay Preacher Training is important in the life of our church. Lay preachers perform a vital role in the ministry of the Uniting Church, continuing the tradition inherited from our Congregational, Methodist and Presbyterian Church forebears.

"I provide resources to presbyteries in their role to accredit, nurture, support and provide continuing education for lay preachers.

"The Uniting Church places importance on training the people of our congregations involved in local educational and leadership activities.

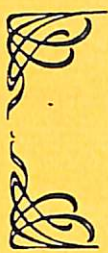
"I organize and lead facilitator training in regions and in presbyteries, providing programs to assist lay people to engage in education for discipleship and ministry.

"I invite elders' and parish councils and others in leadership roles to contact me to plan leadership training to fit the needs of your local congregation or parish.

"I organize seminars, workshops and series on lay education for ministry which will be of value to the people of the church. I invite interested people who would like to join the mailing list to contact me to obtain the program and possibilities for next year.
