Milk Stout picked gold at the recent Australian International Beer Awards.

Frankston's Grum Knight, who started the business with Frase Rettie in 2014, said the pair were "really proud" of their Milk Stout.

The men met while working in IT in 2000 and started home brewing together years later while living in the UK and Europe.

The business name reflected that, with Mr Knight coming up with the idea after realising both men were ex-IT workers using beer to exit the industry.

They have won multiple AIBA awards, including gold for Best Amber in 2017 and gold for the Double Milk Stout last year.
