

Boyd sculpture for SSB building

Australian sculptor Mr. Guy Boyd has finished a work commissioned by the State Savings Bank for installation in its not yet completed building on the corner of Swanston Street and Flinders Lane.

The work, cast in bronze, is 8 feet high in deep relief and 7½ feet wide.

It will be exhibited on a marble wall designed to set off the color of the bronze.

Mr. Boyd said yester-

day the sculpture was "an impressionistic version of the association between the bank and the people".

Branches symbolically placed between the two figures "represent the fruits of the association".
