Robin Boyd dies

MELBOURNE, Sun. : Robin Boyd, one of Australia's great architects, died on Friday night after a short illness.

Mr. Boyd (52) caught a virus infection in Britain while on a tour he began in July.

There will be a private family funeral service tomorrow morning.

A tribute by his profession, clients and friends will be held at 3 p.m. tomorrow at Robert Russell House in St. Kilda road.

Mr. Boyd is survived by his wife Patricia, a son, Penleigh (23), and two daughters, Mandy and Susan.

Mr. Boyd wrote several books, the best-known of which was probably "The Australian Ugliness".

He designed the Australian displays at Montreal Expo in 1967 and Osaka Expo last year.
