"Robin Boyd was one of Australia's greatest architects," the former President of the Victorian Branch of the Royal Australian Institute of Architects, Mr Peter McIntyre, said yesterday.

Boyd died in the Royal elbourne Hospital on Melbourne Friday night after a four week illness.

"He was an architect with an international reputation, Mr McIntyre said.

Mr Boyd was severely critical of many designs prominent in Australian Australian prominent

architecture.

Of St Kilda Rd, he once wrote: "Once (it was) a leafy road with hardly one bad building.

"What they have done to St Kilda Rd is like someone putting a maxi-skirt on the Venus de Milo . . . the gaudy petty new, comic ouildings . . . I don't strip of carnival buildings. think the word tragic is too emotional."

Among the other buildings Mr Boyd designed are Domain Park, Melare Domain Park, Mer-bourne's first air-conditioned high rise apartment block, the John Batman Motor Inn, the Zoology Building at the Australian National University and Menzies c LaTrobe University. In 1969 he v college at

won the Australian Institute of Architects gold medal while he was still working on the "dinosaur" — Australia's building at Expo 70 in

Osaka. Boyd even though he hated the ugliness that has grown around the city
