ROBIN BOYD DEAD, 52

Melbourne architect, Mr Robin Boyd, died last night.

He died in Royal Melbourne Hospital after a four-week illness.

He was 52.

A close friend said today that Mr Boyd caught a virus during a trip to Britain where he judged the international competition for the new Houses of Parliament at Westminster.

From his home in Walsh St., South Yarra, his widow, Mrs Patricia Boyd said: "I am very distressed.

"We are all shocked. It was sudden.

Mr Boyd had a son, Penleigh, 23, who is also an architect; a married daughter, Mandy, who lives in Queensland; and a daughter, Susan, 17, who is still at school.

Mr Boyd designed the Australian displays at the Montreal Expo in 1967 and Osaka Expo last year.

He was a member of the Melbourne Underground Rail Loop Authority.
