Good news from Penguin, and I enclose a copy of their letter. Basically, financial arrangements will remain the same, except that the royalty percentage will now apply on a higher retail price. With their long list of books Penguins sometimes seem to take a very long while issuing reprints, and it could be well into 1978 before we see the new edition.

You will see that I made no suggestion to John Hooker about a person to write the foreword.
