

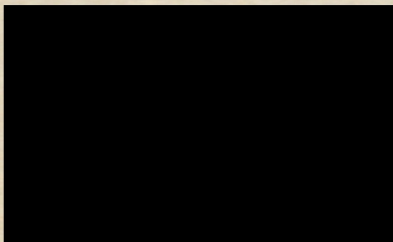

We acknowledge that this morning you returned your set of keys to this office and the electric typewriter which had been in use at your home and that you also returned the High Court Competition file.

However, we also need you to return the Orlando Wines file urgently together with all those documents which you hold in relation to the structure and/or finance of this Company.

The only other outstanding items requiring your attention for proper settlement of your departure from this Company are those listed in my letter to you dated September 29, 1972, which are of extreme importance and which we have no doubt you will finalise with complete integrity.

We have today issued a Group Certificate to [REDACTED] covering the period 31/7/1972 (when he was put on permanent employment basis) to 22/9/1972 when his last pay cheque was issued.

We attach herewith an up to date statement of your own income as from the first day of July this year. It is obvious, of course, that no settlement of outstanding cash claims can be made until a correct financial settlement is made on the Allandale and Malvern Private Hospital projects on which both you and [REDACTED] spent a major proportion of the month of September, 1972 and most of the preceding month.
