As the above list shows, in the past three years 17 Beefs have written once; 8 twice; 1 (Brother Nevile, bless his generous heart) 4 times; and 2 (Brothers Herring and Derham) seem to have escaped the net altogether. The new rota has therefore been devised to entrap first of all the two escapees; then the singletons (in the order of their non-appearance); and finally the twosomes; Brother Nevile being on three years leave of absence from authorship.

Masters These make a little more sense (Beefs seem not to struggle so hard against being Master as they do against writing the records), 18 Beefs having been Master once and 10 twice. A full house.

The list of Masters and Writers of the Records for 1967-8 has been drawn up in strict order of precedence - with minor adjustments to prevent a Master having to write his own records - and should satisfy the sea-lawyers among us.
