Dear *Robin,*

We are beginning to give preliminary thought to the establishment of teaching architecture at Monash University. This is not likely to come about until 1967 but there are many matters of general principle to be resolved before we can even start looking for a Professor.

Professor Hunt, Dean of the Faculty of Engineering, and I have had a number of discussions about the whole question and we have reached a stage where it would be very useful if we could have a talk with a small number of senior members of the architectural profession to get their views.
