Christmas Eve is a very special time for family, friends, neighbours and workmates to gather together to share and celebrate the season of goodwill and giving.

Gathering to sing carols of joy and celebration is an ancient tradition and one which Vision Australia shares across Australia through the magic of Vision Australia's Carols by Candlelight[®].

This special event, held at the Sidney Myer Music Bowl for more than half a century, began back in 1938. As the nation was emerging from one period of hardship to soon enter into another world war, radio announcer Norman Banks organised a night of communal song in Alexandra Gardens. Over the next two decades, through the challenges of war and the joys of peace and prosperity, the event strengthened and grew.

By the time Johnny O'Keefe was crooning Silent Night in the late 1950s, the Christmas Eve tradition was a special part of Melbourne's festive season celebrations and 100,000 people were enjoying the evening in the Sidney Myer Music Bowl.

Even back then we were raising funds to support children who are blind or have low vision and that tradition of giving is what continues to make this event part of the spirit of Christmas. Vision Australia depends on this spirit of generosity to continue to provide free services to children who are blind or have low vision.

Through the past three decades, Vision Australia's Carols by Candlelight has reached millions across Australia thanks to the Nine Network's telecast.

So wherever you are this festive season, enjoy the show and have a happy and safe Christmas.

This spirit of celebration, sharing and giving is particularly exciting for children. One young boy, Sam, is this year's 'Face of Carols' and he represents all the children who will benefit from the fundraising from this special evening.

Children who are blind or have low vision face significant challenges and for them, learning about the world can be tricky. However, through our specialised teams, Vision Australia works in partnership with children and their parents and we embrace the responsibility of meeting their various challenges with great passion and commitment.

As each child is different, we tailor-make programs to manage everyday activities, like how to eat a meal using cutlery or read a story-book which has braille dots. This helps to bring them confidence to interact with others, play with their friends, do their schoolwork and develop into self-assured young adults. Thanks to this expert support, they also have a better chance of getting a job and moving through life with more confidence.

With another 9,000 Australians set to lose their sight before next Christmas, we rely on the support of generous individual donors, businesses and service groups to continue to meet this growing demand.

Sam, our official 'Face of Carols'...

Sam loves going to school and playing basketball with all his friends. He also enjoys acting, dancing, music and is part of the school choir.

But almost nine years ago, when Sam was just seven weeks of age, his parents were shocked to learn that their baby had developed cataracts; something most people associate with old age but which can even affect babies.

"It was heart-breaking," says Debbie, Sam's mother. "It's not what you want for any child, but especially your own child. It was really quite devastating for us, a very challenging time."

At just eight weeks of age, Sam's cataracts were operated on and he was fitted with contact lenses at three months.

"After the operation I made the call to Vision Australia and asked for some support. They were fantastic and came to our house the next day. We spoke to an early childhood educator and she explained about the services and what support she could give us. She visited us once a week for a month or so and then on a needs basis until Sam was five."

The early childhood educator and Sam's parents did years of work using special techniques to build on Sam's remaining vision and encourage his eyes to work together, along with physiotherapy and orthoptic assessments.

Sam now wears special glasses over his lenses to assist with reading and must wear sunglasses out of doors



because of sensitivity to glare. He wears prescription goggles for swimming and loves being in the water.

One of Sam's challenges is that it's not immediately obvious that he's vision-impaired, explains his mother.

"He's often squinting to see and he needs to be more careful moving around unfamiliar spaces," she says. "At this stage he doesn't use a cane and may never need one. But when he gets home from school he's pretty tired from all the concentrating he needs to keep up. That's when things like talking books are helpful – he loves books and can listen to one rather than read one when his eyes are tired."

Thanks to the combined efforts of Sam's parents and Vision Australia, Sam can enjoy school. He can also enjoy family things such as cooking (pizza is a favourite), using the computer and bouncing on the trampoline in the backyard.

With ongoing community support, Vision Australia will continue to ensure children who are blind or have low vision can take part in all the things they and their families want for them.

This Christmas, please help Vision Australia to give kids like Sam the best possible start to life.


