



It is a very special night when Vision Australia depends on the generosity of Australians to support the families of children who are blind or have low vision.

Vision Australia knows that it is particularly important for children who are blind or have low vision to receive specialist assistance from an early age. So much learning occurs through observation and copying but, without visual stimulus, babies and children who are blind or have low vision need special encouragement to develop the physical skills necessary for independence.

For example, Vision Australia teaches parents the techniques they can use to encourage their children to build muscle strength so they can walk confidently holding a cane.

And, Vision Australia's unique Feelix Library helps children who are vision impaired to make the connection between braille dots on a page and the words their parents read from a story book.

Professional help is vital to assist families of children who are blind or have low vision and demand for services is rising.

Vision Australia wants to ensure that every child who is blind or has low vision can reach the same milestones as sighted children. To do this, we rely on the generosity of Australians and fundraising events such as this.

So, whether you're at the live show in Melbourne, among the national audience watching on the Nine Network or listening to the audio-described broadcast on Vision Australia Radio on Christmas Eve, thank you for your support, enjoy the show and have a happy and safe Christmas.


Vision Australia's Carols by Candlelight has become a Christmas Eve tradition for many families across Australia.


Karl Stefanovic and Lisa Wilkinson

Stan Walker


