A beloved Australian tradition

Vision Australia's Carols by Candlelight has a remarkable history of supporting children who are blind or have low vision, and this year marks the 80th anniversary for the iconic Christmas celebration.

Eighty years ago, the vision of one man, Norman Banks MBE, created what has become Australia's most iconic Christmas event, Carols by Candlelight. Since then Carols by Candlelight has brought joy to millions of Australians celebrating Christmas.

Banks, a veteran of radio, was walking home on Christmas Eve in 1937, when he noticed an elderly woman sitting up in bed by her window, her face lit only by a candle. She had a radio beside her and was singing along to the Christmas carol, *Away in a Manger*. It was at this moment that Banks was inspired to create a gathering of people to sing Carols by Candlelight. A spark of inspiration came through Dot Dawson, the powerhouse radio presenter who went on to become one of Australia's greatest women broadcasters, who gifted the event its now iconic title.

It was not easy to gain general support for the idea, but thanks to the gracious personal interest of the Lord Mayor at the time, Cr. A.W. Coles, Banks received the approval of the City Council and set to work to organise the whole program.

And so, in 1938, 10,000 people gathered at midnight in the Alexandra Gardens to sing carols with a 30-strong choir, two soloists and the Metropolitan Fire Brigade Band. The unusual candlelight setting, and the beauty of the carols, instantly won the affection of the large assembly. A new Christmas tradition was born.

The candles lit in 1938 have burned through prosperous and troubled times. Even with Australia in the grip of the Second World War, the candles continued to burn on Christmas Eve. Then came the Brown Out year when, although the Festival was scheduled to be presented at Alexandra Gardens, war-time restrictions and the threat of a Japanese invasion necessitated a transfer to the Baptist Church.

Australia's Queen of Song, Gladys Moncrieff, appeared on the program in 1942, and throughout the early years, many famous artists have been associated with Carols by Candlelight, including Madame Florence Austral, Gilda Grauen and other prominent Victorian artists including Robert Simmons, Mary Miller, Robert Payne, William Laird and John Lanigan. It was also in 1942 that an international radio hook-up was arranged, and during the evening, messages were relayed to the audience from the Lord Mayors of London and New York.

From 1949, RVIB (now Vision Australia) became the main beneficiary with the Austin Hospital. In the first year, it received 7,543 pounds earmarked for the new nursery and school on Burwood Road. In 1959, the venue was changed from Alexandra Gardens to the new Sidney Myer Music Bowl where more than 100,000 people attended.

In 1970, Carols by Candlelight was televised for the first time on Channel 0. Channel 9 took over in 1979 and has continued to be a broadcast partner ever since.

And so, through the years, the festival has grown in Melbourne and captured the imagination of audiences throughout the world. It has been emulated in Australian cities and is now an annual feature in many countries. Over the years the number of famous guests has also increased with appearances by favourites such as Denis Walter, Marina Prior, Silvie Paladino, David Hobson, John Farnham, Debra Byrne, Delta Goodrem, James Morrison, Guy Sebastian, Hi-5 and this year's Ambassador, Anthony Callea (pictured).

Music makes Pravit's world go round

Music is a big part of little Pravit's life – and he might get a special music treat this Christmas Eve at Vision Australia's Carols by Candlelight. Pravit and his Indian-born parents – his father Harshil and mother Sneha – are Hindu, but Carols by Candlelight is a part of their end-of-year celebrations.

Pravit, who has just turned one, struggles to see his keyboard but he throws his body into playing it on the floor. He climbs on it, playing the keys with his hands, knees and feet, and sometimes rests his head near the speaker to heighten the sensation.

He is blind in his right eye and can see only light, colour and shapes through his left. But, he is bright, happy and healthy, and his development is keeping pace with sighted children his age. Vision Australia has been there for every step, working with Pravit since he was one week old.

In fact, Harshil says Vision Australia's early childhood specialist teacher Beth Glover is a big part of the family's life, teaching the whole family techniques and skills to aid Pravit's development.

"It's a miracle. He is coping with all these things. He's growing really well."

A Vision Australia orientation and mobility specialist has introduced Pravit to a white cane before he takes his first step. For now, the end of the cane spends more time in Pravit's mouth than anywhere else, but in time the early exposure should pay dividends.

Festive Cheer

While the family is Hindu, Harshil says they enjoy the spirit of Christmas. "We enjoy Christmas. We attend Christmas parties and New Year's parties and we love the shopping because everything's on sale! You can feel it when Christmas comes in. I really enjoy it."

Sneha says she has watched Carols by Candlelight on Christmas Eve. "It's completely different for us because we don't have carols in India," she says. "I saw it on TV. It's beautiful." And now, Carols has a much greater significance for Pravit's family. "Definitely, I'm going to take Pravit to the Carols."

Born with oculocutaneous albinism, a congenital disorder which affects the eyes, the hair and the skin, best friends Sammy and Lucy first met when their mum's were introduced to each other by Vision Australia.

"I remember seeing this girl that looked just like me, the only difference was that she was wearing large glasses and a leopard print fluffy jacket – I knew right away that we were destined to be great friends," says Sammy. "We bond over our albinism, but at the end of the day we're just normal kids who want to have fun and experiment with fashion and beauty."

They have done some amazing things together including starting up an Instagram account where they share incredible

fashion and beauty photo's. "We wanted to create awareness about our condition, especially for others that may have the same condition as us," says Lucy.

"It has been an incredible journey and we are humbled by all of the comments that we get, especially from parents of children just like us."

Most recently, in support of Vision Australia's Carols by Candlelight, the girls were invited to participate in the film shoot for the Priceline Pharmacy Carols' promotion where they had the chance to meet and chat to Australian fashion model and Priceline Pharmacy Ambassador, Samantha Harris.

Sammy and Lucy were also able to experiment with the incredible range of makeup and beauty products and even managed to get some tips from the Priceline Pharmacy beauty expert!

They are both very excited for Christmas. 

Seeing the world in a different way A letter to Vision Australia from Amy – mum of 20-month-old Parker

When Parker was 3 months old I knew there was something wrong. I couldn't tell anyone; not my husband, my mother, no one could know. I needed the time to prepare, to build up the courage and the strength to fight whatever was on the horizon.

I remember clear as day standing in the maternal health office at Parker's four-month-old appointment. The maternal health nurse turned to me and asked "do you have any concerns?" I knew this was it, I brought up all that courage, and all that strength, took a deep breath and said "his eyes". She looked me straight in the eye and asked "are you ready for this?" I knew in that moment that this was going to be far more devastating than anything I could have ever imagined ... "I'm ready."

How wrong was I ... you can never be ready for this.

A few days later we were visiting with one of Melbourne's leading children's eye doctors hearing that our tiny, beautiful, innocent four-month-old baby has severely low vision, with a very high risk of one day becoming blind. It shatters you, it shatters your life and it shatters your dreams. Shortly after we had our first appointment with Vision Australia - we had heard of them but didn't know exactly what they did or what to expect. Let me tell you: they fill in the broken pieces of that shattered life. They don't fix it, no one really can, but they fill in between those shattered pieces. Yes, Vision Australia has an amazing staff of occupational therapists, psychologists, physiotherapists and mobility trainers but most of all they are our family.

Vision Australia gives you support, they give you strength when you have nothing left to give. They give you hope when all seems to be lost, and they give you the courage to move forward. A year and a half has now passed since Parker's first diagnosis. He is a happy, confident, independent little boy. Our family is happier, stronger and more excited about the future than we ever thought we could be. We owe that all to Vision Australia for showing us that this is not a disability but an ability to see the world in a different way.

From all of the Vision Australia families we thank you for showing your support at Carols by Candlelight and into the future.

Vision Australia assists families to help their children achieve the greatest levels of independence

The money raised through Carols By Candlelight helps us to provide the vital support families need, when and where they need it, to make sure their children can live the lives they choose.

Each child is unique, and as a parent or carer you know they interact and learn in their own wonderful way.

Finding out your child is blind or has low vision can turn your world upside down. You may have all sorts of questions. What does the future hold for them? How will they manage at school? How will this affect our family?

Much of what we learn in life is through watching. So, children who are blind or have low vision need to gather information about their world in different ways - parents and carers are their first and favourite teacher. **We do this through:**

- Helping a parent or carer understand their child's vision.
- Building strategies to maximise a child's learning opportunities.
- Assessing the home environment and identifying opportunities to support a child's learning and development.
- Encouraging the development of speech and language, and supporting communication between a child and their parents, siblings, carers and peers.
- Supporting parents in conversations with schools to enable them to confidently talk to teachers about their child's needs.
- Assistance in developing social skills to support inclusion.
- Advice with school-age braille, reading and writing technology and equipment support.
- Supporting teenagers to explore career opportunities, further study and more.
- Membership of our Feelix and Youth Libraries.

The Feelix Library for children aged 0-7 years who are blind or have low vision:

Reading plays a key role in the learning and development of any child, and through the support of the generous donations received at Carols by Candlelight, Feelix can help children learn and develop in a unique, sensory way to support literacy.

The purpose behind the Feelix Library is to help children who are blind or have low vision to have the same experience with books as their sighted peers. Story kits help parents, carers and teachers bring stories to life for children through books, audio and touch. Story kits are also available in languages including Chinese, Vietnamese, Turkish and Arabic. These kits allow parents to read to their children in not only their native language, but with toys, Braille and audio accompaniments.

With the help of funds raised from Carols by Candlelight, the service has been incredibly successful, starting with just 20 members, we now work with more than 550 children, over 100 teachers and almost 50 kindergarten's nationwide.

"I was a mess. I couldn't have had worse news. Every time I walked into the room I'd scare him. He'd start crying because he couldn't see me," she says.

"Vision Australia came out to support him and me as a new mum. They taught me to be a little softer with my voice and gave us exercises to do, and it really helped. But then we had a miracle. His vision appeared just before Christmas that year. He just had delayed vision."

Drazenka says she made a pledge, because she was so grateful to Vision Australia and for Oliver's sudden recovery. "I promised that every year we would go to Carols by Candlelight and give back because Vision Australia was there for us. We will be there for them every single year without fail," she says.

Birthday surprise

For Sydneysider Daphne, Christmas isn't Christmas without Vision Australia's Carols by Candlelight, but she had never attended before partner Glenn surprised her for her 50th birthday in 2015.
