## Overview

- 6. The following points should be noted:
- a. The Department of Forests, Conservation and Land has reaffirmed the squadrons use of the Cobram CTA until at the end of 1988.
  Allowable use includes the use of A vehicles. Usage is limited to a maximum of 6 times per year.
- b. A Commonwealth Employment Programme (C.E.P.) grant of \$25,296 has been obtained to re establish the unit museum at Buna Barracks.
- c. Concern exists within the unit about usage of Beersheba Barracks by visiting units. It is considered that the usage of the depots and the requirements of visiting units are becoming excessive for the squadron.

### Conclusion

7. A Sqn 8/13 VMR is currently operating effectively at its four depots and has a sound manning profile.
