FORM OF BEQUEST.

I bequeath the sum of £ _____ to the
Treasurer for the time being of the Adult Deaf
and Dumb Mission of Victoria, for the use of
the said Mission, for which the receipt of
such Treasurer shall be sufficient discharge.

CONSTITUTION.

I.—NAME.

"The Adult Deaf and Dumb Mission of Victoria."

II.—OBJECTS.

- 1.—To provide the means for religious worship and instruction for the adult deaf and dumb of Victoria.
- 2.—To visit the deaf and dumb in their homes, especially when sick or in distress.
- 3.—To assist the deaf and dumb of good character in obtaining suitable employment.
- 4.—To provide technical and other education for the adult deaf and dumb.
- 5.—To give pecuniary assistance to adult deaf and dumb who are in need.

III.—MEMBERSHIP.

Every subscriber of 10/- and upwards shall be a member of the Mission for the period of 12 calendar months from the date of his subscription, and every donor of £10 and upwards shall be a life member. Any annual meeting may, upon the recommendation of the Committee, elect as a life member any person who, in the opinion of the meeting, shall have rendered signal service to the Mission.

IV.—MANAGEMENT.

The management of the Mission shall be vested in a Committee, consisting of a President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Secretary and twelve other members. They shall be elected annually, and shall hold office until the close of the annual meeting succeeding their election, or any adjournment thereof. They shall have full power to act, notwithstanding any vacancies in their number.

V.—MEETINGS OF MEMBERS.

An annual meeting of members shall be held in Melbourne in the month of April, or as soon thereafter as circumstances will permit. At such meeting a report of the proceedings of the previous financial year shall be presented, together with an audited account of receipts and disbursements, and the officers and Committee for the year thence ensuing shall then be elected. Special meetings of the members may be called by the Committee, and shall be so called upon a request in writing, signed by not less than twenty members.

VI.—DUTIES AND POWERS OF COMMITTEE.

The Committee shall meet at least once a quarter, and three shall form a quorum. The minutes of each meeting shall be taken by the Secretary, and duly recorded in a book to be kept for that purpose. The Committee shall have power to fill up all vacancies which may occur in said Committee during their term of office, to appoint a Missionary, to make arrangements for the conduct of public worship, of Bible classes or other religious services, and to adopt and carry out any means deemed necessary to secure the objects of the Mission, and to increase its usefulness. The Committee shall also have power to make or amend by-laws for the regulation of their own proceedings, and for the guidance of the Missionary.

VII.—ALTERATION OF RULES.

No alteration of rules or additions thereto shall be made except by a meeting of the members of the Mission, convened in accordance with Rule V. One month's notice of any intended alteration or addition not proposed by the Committee, shall be given to the Committee in writing. The Committee shall, not less than one week prior to the meeting at which any alteration or addition may be proposed, advertise notice of the intention to propose an alteration or addition in one newspaper published in Melbourne, and shall, from the date of such advertisement, furnish particulars of the proposed alteration or addition to any member requiring the same.

TWENTY-SECOND ANNUAL
REPORT
OF THE
Adult Deaf and Dumb Mission of Victoria,
FOR YEAR ENDING 31ST MARCH, 1906.

IN presenting their annual report, the Committee draw attention to the report of the deaf sub-committee which is appended to it. This contains information as to the inner working of the Mission, and details of the various meetings and functions which have been held, both of an instructive and social character. Although it does not profess to give a statement of the benefits which the deaf have derived from the operation of the Mission, it shows their appreciation of those benefits, and the gladness that it has brought into their lives, and which it is one of the chief objects of the Society to promote.

It is a matter of great satisfaction to the Committee to note the constant and increasing sense of gratitude which is the keynote of the sub-committee's report. The subscribers will, no doubt, share the feeling of the Committee that the money which enables these unfortunate ones to lose their feeling of isolation by enjoying the companionship of others is well spent.

Amongst the most useful of the operations of the Mission is the circulation of a monthly letter or report, compiled by members of the Mission, and printed by hand, and multiplied at considerable trouble. This is sent to all the adult deaf mutes in the State so far as is known. It is greatly appreciated, especially by those who reside in the country and have not the advantages of their city brethren. It also tends to

make them more satisfied with their lot, cut off as they are from personal intercourse with their own people.

The problem of finding work for the unemployed is ever with us. From various causes there are generally some who are out of work through no fault of their own, and whose wages have been so small that they have not been able to save money. To look to the Mission for funds for subsistence is distasteful to them, as it must be to any self-respecting man, and from every point of view it is undesirable. The Committee feel that the only remedy for the trouble would be the apprenticing of the youths in their early years to some handicraft in which the demand for skilled labour is constant. The difficulty is to find employers who are willing to incur the self-sacrifice which is entailed in teaching or engaging operatives whose deprivation of hearing necessarily entails some inconvenience.

At present there are several without employment, and of various occupations. One is a clerk, another a bookbinder, whose hand has been so injured by being caught in some machinery as to result in his losing his engagement. Both are married men with families. These and others who are unable to obtain employment have started a business of selling goods from house to house. The Committee have made them a grant to enable them to commence with sufficient capital, on the understanding that it is to be repaid if the venture proves successful. It is too early to report as to results, but the Committee hope for the best.

A number of the young women desire to learn the art of dressmaking, either with a view to utilise it as a means of living, or for personal use. The Committee deem this worthy of encouragement. They have, therefore, purchased a sewing machine, and have arranged with a competent dressmaker to give lessons to those who desire instruction. The class has commenced with a very satisfactory number.

During the year the Mission has suffered a loss through the death of Mr. William Deane, a respected member, who has been identified with it since its inception. Under his will, this Mission and its sister one in South Australia have benefited to the extent of £80.

Now that the Mission premises have been sufficiently completed for the present, the Committee are glad to have some funds at their disposal for the relief of indigent members, who cannot possibly earn their own living. The blind, deaf

men, referred to in the last report, are still the recipients of pecuniary assistance. In any event it is necessary for the public to help them in some form, and the Mission thus takes this part of the duty, while affording them at the same time the advantage of intercourse with the rest of their fellows.

During the year a public meeting has been held under the auspices of the Victorian branch of the Australasian Deaf and Dumb Association, at which the Premier, the Hon. Thomas Bent, presided. Its object was partly to impress upon the Government the importance of providing for the compulsory education of the deaf. With this the Committee cordially agree. As the Society which looks after the interests of all the adult deaf of Victoria, who associate themselves with it, the Mission is deeply interested in this matter. Unless they receive a training as children in the Victorian Institution for the Deaf and Dumb, it cannot be expected that, in after life, they will be competent to maintain themselves and their families in comfort, or to approximate in intellectual attainment and refinement of disposition to those of the community who are compelled by force of law to receive an education either in a public or private school. The Committee record their thanks to the Hon. the Premier for the sympathy and interest which he evinced in the welfare of the deaf.

The Committee also endorse the protest which has been made by the Association referred to against the section of the Marine Act 1890, which gives a discretionary power to a Government officer to prevent deaf mutes from landing in the State, unless a bond be entered into for their support for five years. Such legislation the Committee considers to be offensive and unnecessary.

Some particulars of services which various ladies and gentlemen have rendered to the Mission by way of lectures, donations of money and useful articles, and in other ways, will be found in the report of the sub-committee, and in various parts of this report. It is impossible, however, to mention the names of all who have given time and trouble to entertain and assist the deaf, and in various ways to brighten their lives and help them intellectually and morally. To all such, as well as the subscribers, the Committee tender their grateful thanks on behalf of the members of the Mission.



A Successful Year.

IN placing before the members of the Adult Deaf and Dumb Mission their eighteenth annual report, it affords the sub-committee much pleasure to be in a position to inform them that the proceedings of the past twelve months have been in almost every way successful and satisfactory. There is a decided improvement in the affairs of the Mission, and it is highly gratifying to note that the progress is general. Another pleasant feature is the good feeling which exists among the members. Each year, since the Mission was formed, has brought us into closer and more enduring fellowship with one another; there is a warm sympathy in one another's joys and sorrows, and “love” is the beautiful thought that rules us all. The “kingdom of heaven upon earth” is the ideal ever before us. There has been much activity on the part of the better educated members. They have taken up with enthusiasm the central idea of our Mission, i.e., having once found, never to lose sight of, any one of our silent community. Our building is indeed the central rallying point of the deaf and dumb, towards which they can always look with certainty for sympathy, protection and help, and to which they can go for friendly intercourse, instruction, recreation, and mutual observance of religious service.

Since we became occupants of the new building, two years back, we have had many new experiences, and those years will stand out in our memory as a period of exceptional progress. But the past year, with all its blessings, has not been without its sorrows. Two of our members have crossed the bar, three have met with accidents, many have had illnesses, and several have known, and still know, the anxieties that come to the unemployed. But, thank God, our Mission enables us to say there has never been, and we hope never will be, a case of actual want.

The Committee.

We desire to express our grateful thanks to the Mission Committee for the untiring and sympathetic interest they have always manifested for us, and also for their readiness to comply with our petitions whenever made. We desire specially to record our gratitude towards Mr. H. Sumner Martin, the Honorary Secretary, Mr. Edward Newbiggin, the Honorary Treasurer, Rev. J. J. Halley, and Mr. E. R. Peacock, for personal interest and help in various ways.

Divine Services.

Divine service has been conducted regularly every Sunday morning and evening. The ministrations of our Chaplain (Mr. Abraham) continue to attract and to influence the congregation for good. His command of our language and graceful style enable him to make

himself understood and appreciated by both advanced and semi-educated. Four mixed services (deaf and hearing) were held during the year, the preachers being Mr. S. Mauger, M.P., the Rev. S. J. Hoban, and Mr. Abraham, who officiated twice in the dual capacity of preaching and interpreting his own address, and he also officiated at the second anniversary celebration of the opening of the building, and at his fourth anniversary of ministrations among us. Miss Le Huray, who is ever ready to give her services when hearing friends attend, presided at the organ on each occasion. On March 11th, for the second time, a Harvest Thanksgiving Service was held. The church was prettily decorated with flowers, fruit, vegetables, etc., presented by deaf members and hearing friends. Our Chaplain preached in the morning, and was assisted by Mr. R. R. Paterson in the evening. The products were distributed amongst the poorer members. The attendances at the services have been fairly well maintained, particularly in the evenings. The average attendance was:—Morning, 22; evening, 44; highest, 60; lowest, 10 (a very wet day). The Lord's Supper was administered on four occasions—by the Revs. J. Hosking, J. J. Halley and our Chaplain. On the two former occasions Mr. Abraham interpreted.

Bible Classes.

Bible classes have been held, with few exceptions, weekly, on Thursday evenings. Our members have always shown a deep interest in the study of the Scriptures. This is shown by the good average attendance. In the absence of the Chaplain, when occupied with other duties, or on his holidays, the services and Bible classes have been taken by the following helpers:—Messrs. R. R. Paterson, P. Holt, F. J. Rose, M. L. Miller, J. E. Muir, R. H. Luff, W. P. Muir, A. C. Muir, and E. Burke.

Collections.

The contributions by the deaf members of the congregation for the year totalled £41 17s. 4d. In addition to these amounts, the congregation contributed £4 14s. to the Hospital Sunday Fund, and £2 1s. 6d. to the Bush Fire Relief Fund. Other collections, too, have been made privately to assist deserving members in times of distress.

Rally.

Our first Congregational Rally was held on September 14th, and was a great and pleasing success. Mr. F. J. Rose presided. Mr. R. R. Paterson, our Chaplain, and others gave stirring addresses. There was an attendance of 64. The second Rally was held on December 14th, and was a decided improvement upon the first. Mr. H. Sumner Martin, the Hon. Secretary, presided. Mr. E. R. Peacock and others gave addresses. Attendance, 68. On the first occasion our Chaplain entertained the congregation to supper, and on the second we were the guests of the Mission Committee. There was a ring of loyalty and brotherhood about both these gatherings, and it is expected these quarterly meetings will do much good.

Lectures.

Through the year about a dozen lectures were delivered by our Principal on various entertaining and instructive subjects. The most attractive of these was "The Condition and Needs of the Deaf and Dumb," which was delivered specially to parents and friends of the deaf, of whom there was a large assembly. Mr. R. R. Paterson interpreted. We have also been honoured with several important lectures by well-known gentlemen—the Rev. Dr. Strong, on "Prison Reform and the Onward March of Humanity" (limelight); Miss Halley, on "Missionary Work in China," illustrated by a large number of Chinese curios; Rev. R. H. Lambley, M.A., on "Australian Scenes" (limelight); Rev. Canon Nash, on "Scriptual Food"; Mr. Abraham, on "A Trip Round the World" (limelight); Mr. S. Mauger, M.H.R., on "Child Life and Crime"; Councillor Wilson, of Malvern, and Mr. F. J. Rose, dissolving view entertainment. On each occasion our Principal interpreted. To these gentlemen we tender our very sincere thanks.

"Our Monthly Letter."

It is pleasing to report that "Our Monthly Letter" is in its second year. It is a source of much pleasure and interest to our country brethren, who look forward most eagerly to its arrival month by month, as numerous letters received by the conductors of this paper testify. The circulation is now 220 copies monthly, and many of these, after having been read, are passed on to other deaf mutes living in the same town. The idea of publishing a monthly letter has caught on in other States. Mr. Showell, of Queensland, was the first to follow Victoria's lead, and South Australia is now issuing a news letter. We hope to see N.S.W. making the same provision for their country deaf at an early date. The managing staff of our "Letter," Messrs. M. L. Miller, E. R. Smith, and J. E. Muir, with their helpers, are entitled to the sincere thanks of the whole congregation for their untiring and patient work, and such thanks are here tendered.

Picnic.

The annual Cup Day Picnic was held at Doncaster, in a paddock lent by Mr. E. Lawford, and 100 members and friends attended. A grant of £5 from the Mission Committee, together with other sums subscribed by friends, through Mr. Abraham, enabled the Sub-committee to invite the whole of the poorer members of the Mission to join the outing, and partake of dinner and tea on the grounds.

Socials.

It has become the custom of the deaf to celebrate all events with Socials in their own building. Our affliction draws us closer together, and our greatest pleasure is to be in one another's company, instead of visiting other places of entertainment. Hence many social gatherings are held in our building during the year. The following are perhaps the most important of these events:—A return conversazione to our hearing friends; fourth anniversary of the Deaf Women's Society; social to Mr. C. Hodgson, our old Librarian;

Cricket Club social; and farewell social to Miss Graham, one of our most generous members, prior to her departure for Europe. The congregation, some 70 in number, spent Christmas Day and evening with our Chaplain and his wife at their residence.

Library.

The Sub-committee feel they must say a few words in appreciation of the services of the Hon. Librarian, Mr. M. Mortimer, and his assistant, Mr. J. McLean. Our Library and Reading-rooms are open as often as four times a week (the Reading-room daily), and the work connected therewith is anything but light, for the congregation has availed itself to the full of the large and increasing stock of books, magazines and newspapers. A grant of £10 from the Mission Committee was laid out in the purchase of new volumes, and Mr. A. Williamson has presented to the Library no less than 90 volumes, bound by himself, including a volume of Annual Reports of the Mission since its inception.

Anniversary of our Chaplain.

It is twenty years since Mr. Abraham became a teacher of the deaf, and four years later he was elected Pastor of the Church for the deaf and dumb in the south of London. To celebrate the 20th anniversary of this former event, on July 4th, the congregation presented him with an address, one side being covered with the signatures of the members of the Mission, and the other an address giving expression to their hearty congratulations on the attainment of his 20th anniversary.

To mark their esteem and acknowledge the services of Mr. M. L. Miller, the Sub-committee presented him with a framed group of photographs of themselves.

Saturday Night Gatherings.

The Saturday night gatherings are becoming a very popular feature of our building, especially with the young. Every effort is made to make these meetings as attractive as possible, the object being to keep the members away from questionable places of amusement and the streets. The average attendance is 30, and members of the Sub-committee take charge alternately.

Cricket.

During the season our Cricket Club, although they made a late start, owing to inability to muster a full team, is still holding its own, and going on fairly well. It is to be hoped the Club will have brighter prospects next season.

Sign Class.

At the request of a number of hearing friends anxious to acquire a knowledge of our language, that they might be of greater service to our Mission, Mr. Abraham, during the winter months, conducted a Sign Class every alternate Friday. Quite a large number of friends took advantage of this opportunity of learning how to converse with us.

Bank.

The Outing Fund and Bank was reorganised on April 15th. Mr. F. E. Frewin, the Hon. Treasurer, is taking a very active part in this branch of the work. So far it is but fairly successful, but the number of depositors is on the increase.

A.D.D.A.

On October 17th a general meeting of the deaf and dumb was held to discuss the advisability of forming a Victorian branch of the Australasian Deaf and Dumb Association. It was unanimously agreed that such a branch should be formed, and officers were duly elected. On March 13th, under the auspices of this branch, a crowded public meeting was held in our building. The Premier (the Hon. T. Bent) presided, and our President (Mr. Abraham) gave a vigorous address on "The Case of the Deaf Mute," which aroused great interest and sympathy on the part of the public. At the close of his remarks Mr. Bent promised to consider our case in detail, and, if satisfied, to give his help in bringing about better conditions of the deaf. Mr. Fred. Frewin interpreted.

Marriages.

Seven members of the congregation entered the marriage state during the year.

Deaths.

It is with deep regret we record the deaths of the year. Mrs. James Martin died on April 11th, 1905, and Mr. W. Deane on February 24th, 1906. The former was the dearest benefactress we ever had. She was greatly loved, and is sorely missed. For twenty years she was an active worker amongst us. The Sub-committee have had a portrait of Mrs. Martin enlarged and framed, and it now hangs in the Library. Mr. W. Deane was an old member of the Mission. He came to the colonies 55 years ago, and was a resident of Prahran for 38 years. He died at the age of 80.

Conclusion.

Having brought to a close their report of events passed, your Sub-committee would urge upon every member to make the success of the Mission a matter of personal interest. There are still some who do not take advantage of the provisions made for them at our building, and whom we would delight to welcome to our devotional and friendly gatherings. The advantages to be obtained at our building are now so many that no single deaf person should be outside its portals. We pray for the day when the name of every deaf mute will be found on its roll of membership, and we urge every present member not only to be untiring in their efforts to enrol new members, but to see that they are regular in attendance, when they do join. We hope that the amicable relations between the incoming Committee and the members will be as strong, if not stronger, than those enjoyed by us during the past year, and whilst we all continue devotedly to bestow our time and talents to the good of the deaf.



Our fourth anniversary was celebrated during the year, and about 40 were present. This was concluded by a coffee supper, given by the President and Committee of the Society.
