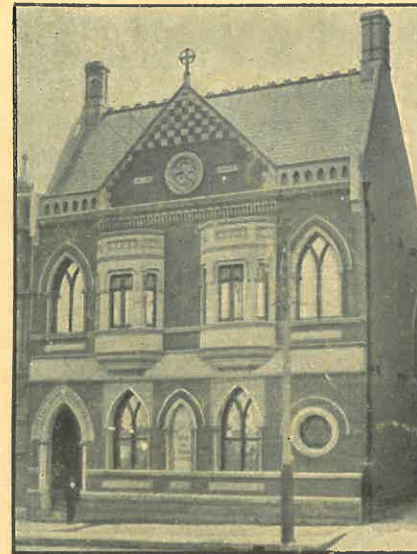

CONSTITUTION.

—*—

I.—NAME.

"The Adult Deaf and Dumb Mission of Victoria."

II.—OBJECTS.

- 1.—To provide the means for religious worship and instruction for the adult deaf and dumb of Victoria.
- 2.—To visit the deaf and dumb in their homes, especially when sick or in distress.
- 3.—To assist the deaf and dumb of good character in obtaining suitable employment.
- 4.—To provide technical and other education for the adult deaf and dumb.
- 5.—To give pecuniary assistance to adult deaf and dumb who are in need.

III.—MEMBERSHIP.

Every subscriber of 10s. and upwards shall be a member of the Mission for the period of 12 calendar months from the date of his subscription, and every donor of £10 and upwards shall be a life member. Any annual meeting may upon the recommendation of the Committee elect as a life member any person, who, in the opinion of the meeting, shall have rendered signal service to the Mission.

IV.—MANAGEMENT.

The management of the Mission shall be vested in a Committee, consisting of a President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Secretary, and twelve other members. They shall be elected annually, and shall hold office until the close of the annual meeting succeeding their election, or any adjournment thereof. They shall have full power to act, notwithstanding any vacancies in their number.

V.—MEETINGS OF MEMBERS.

An annual meeting of members shall be held in Melbourne in the month of April, or as soon thereafter as circumstances will permit. At such meeting a report of the proceedings of the previous financial year shall be presented, together with an audited account of receipts and disbursements, and the officers and committee for the year thence ensuing shall then be elected. Special meetings of the members may be called by the Committee, and shall be so called upon a request in writing, signed by not less than twenty members.

VI.—DUTIES AND POWERS OF COMMITTEE.

The Committee shall meet at least once a quarter, and three shall form a quorum. The minutes of each meeting shall be taken by the Secretary, and duly recorded in a book to be kept for that purpose. The Committee shall have power to fill up all vacancies which may occur in said Committee during their term of office, to appoint a Missionary, to make arrangements for the conduct of public worship, of bible classes or other religious services, and to adopt and carry out any means deemed necessary to secure the objects of the Mission, and to increase its usefulness. The Committee shall also have power to make or amend by-laws for the regulation of their own proceedings, and for the guidance of the Missionary.

VII.—ALTERATION OF RULES.

No alteration of rules or additions thereto shall be made except by a meeting of the members of the Mission, convened in accordance with Rule V. One month's notice of any intended alteration or addition not proposed by the Committee, shall be given to the Committee in writing. The Committee shall, not less than one week prior to the meeting at which any alteration or addition may be proposed, advertise notice of the intention to propose an alteration or addition in one newspaper published in Melbourne, and shall, from the date of such advertisement, furnish particulars of the proposed alteration or addition to any member requiring the same.

TWENTIETH ANNUAL

REPORT

OF THE

Adult Deaf and Dumb Mission of Victoria.

FOR THE YEAR ENDING MARCH 31st, 1904.

IT is with feelings of great thankfulness, and with gratitude to the public, both of Melbourne and the country, that the Committee announce the completion of the first instalment of the new premises in Flinders Street, Melbourne. For twenty years they have been working and saving with this end in view, feeling that no hired rooms could adequately supply the want of a building constructed to meet the peculiar necessities of those who are the objects of their care. The deaf and dumb are greatly pleased at having a building which they can call their own, and as the best recompense that they can make to those who have acted so generously towards them, the Committee do not doubt that the privileges which they now enjoy will bear fruit in nobler characters, in increased usefulness to their fellows, and in a higher conception of the duties of citizenship.

While naturally rejoicing at taking possession of their new quarters, the deaf feel regret at leaving the Congregational Hall, where they have met so happily for many years. Everything possible has been done to make them feel at home, and they are indebted to the Rev. Dr. Bevan for the personal interest which he has taken in the welfare of the Mission, and to the officers of the Collins Street Independent Church for the consideration which has at all times characterized their dealings with the Committee.

The building has been erected by Mr. H. Henningsen, under the superintendence of Messrs. Klingender and Newbigin. It contains amongst other conveniences an assembly hall capable of

seating 200 persons, a library and reading room, and two separate meeting rooms for men and women. The Missionary will have a private room where he will be easily accessible. This will supply a distinct want in the life of the deaf mute, for he is dependent to a greater extent than his more fortunate fellows upon the counsel of others in his business and private life, while on the other hand it is only those who can converse with him freely in his own language, and can thoroughly comprehend his modes of thought and expression, who are capable of understanding the difficulties and perplexities which beset him, and of tendering the advice which he needs.

The Committee hope to be able to accumulate a comprehensive library, and will be grateful for donations of books and periodicals, either new or second-hand.

They have not yet had time to mature plans for the fuller instruction of the deaf and dumb, now that there are increased facilities for imparting it. They will, however, consider the possibility of supplementing the mental and technical training which they have received before becoming members of the adult community of deaf and dumb, so as to bring them up to the standard of hearing persons, who naturally make more rapid progress in their early years through having all their faculties complete. They also hope to be in a position to follow the example of sister missions, and give pecuniary help in cases of emergency. The deaf and dumb frequently make a precarious living, for they cannot command the same wages as others who, although not more expert, do not entail any trouble in communicating with them. When, therefore, they lose their positions through the exigencies of trade, it is often a difficult matter to get them fresh employment, and in the meantime they are reduced to straits in which it is proper to relieve them. This duty has in the past been thrown chiefly upon the missionary, and the deaf and dumb, who have been thus taxed further than their circumstances can afford. At the same time it is a source of satisfaction to the Committee to see how self-sacrificing the deaf are, in constantly raising funds amongst themselves for those of their number who are in misfortune. In addition they subscribe towards the support of the mission what, in their circumstances, is a generous amount.

In several instances the Missionary has been instrumental in rescuing deaf and dumb persons from degrading surroundings or in distressing circumstances. He has also obtained employment for several who were out of work.

As time goes on the Mission will doubtless become increasingly useful. The number of those who are receiving benefits is becoming perceptibly larger. Amongst others it is interesting and pathetic to notice a blind and deaf man, and another who is deaf and dumb and nearly blind. Both are constant attendants at the Mission meetings, and with the assistance of others are enabled to follow all that is being said from the platform.

There must be many persons in the community who have entirely or practically lost their hearing in their mature years, and who, if they would join the Mission, and persevere in acquiring the finger and sign language, would find that their loss was greatly compensated for by the acquisition of a new circle of friends with whom they could readily interchange thoughts.

The Mission has during the past year suffered the loss of three members of the Committee, viz., the Rev. H. W. H. Adeney, a member of 14 years' standing, who is about to leave the State, and whose interest in the Society and sympathy with the deaf has been unfailing, also the Rev. T. Angwin whose death has deprived the Mission of a friend and wise counsellor, and the Rev. Thos. Tait, whose departure for New Zealand has left the Committee without a representative of the Presbyterian body. It is hoped that other clergymen from the denominations to which these gentlemen belonged will be secured, so that the unsectarian nature of the Mission may be fully provided for.

A trust deed for the new premises has been drawn up and sanctioned by the Committee, and the annual meeting will be asked to approve of it, so that proper provision may be made for the management of the property, and appeals to the court avoided.

The Vice-President, Mr. Edward Newbigin, who has occupied the position of Honorary Treasurer to the Mission nearly the whole period of its existence, and from whom the deaf have received numerous benefits, has found that the increasing work of the Society makes greater demands upon his time than he is justified in fulfilling. He has kindly consented to continue in office, but arrangements will be made to relieve him of portion of the work by the appointment of an assistant Treasurer. On behalf of the deaf and dumb and themselves, the Committee have tendered to him their heartfelt sympathy in the successive bereavements which he has suffered during the past year. They deplore the death of his son, Mr. E. Lesslie Newbigin, designer

and one of the architects of the new building, the completion of which was the last effort of a life full of promise.

The Rev. H. Kelly of Geelong has very kindly undertaken to periodically visit the adult deaf and dumb of that town and the surrounding district. Captain Olden continues to render efficient service as honorary Missionary at Ballarat.

In conclusion, the Committee thank the numerous ladies and gentlemen who have taken an active interest in the work of the Mission during the year, whether in the way of raising funds, taking part in the various public meetings which have been organized, conferring favours on the country collector, or in any other manner showing their sympathy with the deaf and dumb.

EXTRACTS FROM

16th Annual Report of the Deaf Sub-Committee.

It is with feelings of the deepest gratitude that the Sub-committee submit their 16th annual report. Truly the blessing of God has rested upon the operations of the past twelve months, and under Divine guidance much steady and successful work has to be recorded.

First and foremost there is a general feeling of satisfaction amongst the members of the congregation that the much-needed and long-looked-for erection of the church and building has become an accomplished fact. It is felt that with this advantage greater facilities will be afforded for the better carrying on of the Mission work than has hitherto been the case. We are looking forward with the greatest of pleasure to the time when we shall take possession of the new premises, and feel that we are in a place we can call our own.

Our best thanks are due to the Mission committee for their kind consideration of, and endeavours to meet the wishes of the congregation in anything that tends to the immediate improvement of their position and welfare. Our best thanks are also due to Mr. H. S. Martin, the hon. secretary, for his readiness to assist at all times with advice in anything concerning the welfare of the deaf, and to Mrs. James Martin, Mrs. S. Luke, the Misses Mills and Mitchell and other ladies for their valuable services and general interest in the Mission work.

Taking advantage of the convenience of the time during last Christmas, a congress of the Australian deaf and dumb was held in Melbourne. Its being the first important congress ever held in Australia naturally evoked a great deal of interest and enthusiasm among the adult deaf and dumb. There were gathered together some 200 deaf mutes from the various States of the Commonwealth. It was a very representative gathering. The objects of the congress were to advance and protect the interests of the deaf and dumb, and to make an endeavour to have the various injustices under which they labour removed. Congress meetings were held on the 28th and 29th of December, and they were well attended. Various subjects affecting the deaf and dumb were discussed and resolutions were carried. We are pleased to note that the congress was a great success, and it is hoped the seeds so auspiciously sown will in the near future bring forth much good fruit that will affect for the better not only the position of the deaf and dumb of Victoria, but of those of Australia as well. The congress lasted from 24th December, 1903, to 2nd January, 1904, and besides the congress meetings an attractive programme of socials, a picnic, a sports meeting, cricket matches, and other festivities for the entertainment of the guests was arranged and much enjoyed by all present.

A successful exhibition of Arts and Crafts of the deaf and dumb was also held during the currency of the congress, and

articles were received from the various states. The exhibition did much to bring the capabilities of the deaf and dumb under public notice. Our best thanks are due to Mr. Ernest Abraham and his co-adjutors for the able manner in which the congress business was carried through, to the Mission Committee for assistance in the shape of a donation to the congress fund, to Edward Newbigin, Esq., for his courtesy and kindness in entertaining the delegates, visitors, and the deaf and dumb at a picnic, to Messrs. Huddart, Parker & Co. for their kindness in entertaining the company to bay trips in the S.S. "Hygeia," to the Carlton and Melbourne Cricket Clubs for the free use of cricket grounds for the inter-state cricket matches, to the donors of the handsome prizes, etc., for the sports, to Mr. and Mrs. J. Allison for the catering arrangements, to Mr. W. G. Dalziel for his valuable services as hon. manager of the Exhibition, to all those ladies and gentlemen who helped in any way to make the congress a success, and last, but not least, to the press for the kindly interest they took in the congress.

It is with deep regret that we record the following deaths during the year of members and former members of the congregation, viz.:—Miss Nellie O'Brien, Mr. Thos. H. Monahan, Mrs. L. Downes, who was always to the fore in anything connected with the welfare of the mission, Mr. John Hancock and Mrs. Robert Durham, who died from burns received in a plucky attempt to rescue her infant son from a burning house. It was a brave deed which evokes our warmest admiration, and while regretting that the act cost Mrs. Durham her life, we are pleased to know that she succeeded in rescuing her child from a horrible death.

Nine of the members of the congregation entered the marriage state during the year.

We regret to have to record the loss of two esteemed former members of the congregation, viz., Mr. and Mrs. J. A. Tenney, who departed for the United States of America last October, and were always to the fore in anything connected with the welfare of the Mission.

Divine services have been held regularly every Sunday morning and evening throughout the year, and the ministrations of our esteemed leader, Mr. Ernest Abraham, have been much appreciated and most attentively listened to by all present. The attendances at both services have been well maintained. The largest attendances were on the 27th September last, when 125 attended the morning service, and 141 the evening service. The average collection is about 16s. per Sunday. Messrs. F. J. Rose, R. R. Paterson, E. Salas, P. Holt, S. W. Showell, F. S. Booth, J. E. Muir, M. Miller, and H. Luff assisted to conduct services on occasions when Mr. Abraham was unavoidably absent, and our best thanks are due to them for their assistance.

A special and unique service in connection with the congress was held at St. Paul's Cathedral on the afternoon of Sunday 27th December, when the Lord Bishop of Melbourne preached a special sermon.

Bible class meetings have also been held with a few exceptions every Thursday evening. The attendances at these classes have been good.

The usual Hospital Sunday collection was taken in October last, when the congregation contributed the sum of £4 12s. 5d.

The members of the congregation have also helped several deserving cases by means of special collections during the year.

The library has been well looked after during the year, and the members of the congregation have fairly well availed themselves of the opportunities for reading afforded by the stock of books, periodicals, etc.

During June a social evening was held, and another on the 12th March. On the latter occasion the members of the congregation testified their warm appreciation of the special efforts made by Mr. E. Abraham to bring about the erection of the church and premises to a successful issue, and also to his laudable efforts by means of the congress to uplift the general condition of the deaf and dumb, by presenting to him a handsome illuminated address suitably expressive of their feelings.

We desire to record our hearty thanks to Mr. and Mrs. Samuel Johnson, the committees of the South Australian school for the deaf and dumb, and the Adult Deaf and Dumb Mission, and the adult deaf and dumb of Adelaide for the very hearty and kind way in which they received and entertained Mr. E. Abraham during his visit to the sister State, and for their great kindness in receiving, entertaining and accomodating the team of cricketers from Melbourne during Christmas, 1902.

The sub-committee cannot conclude their report without expressing their sense of thankfulness to God for the large measure of success that has attended their efforts during the past twelve months, and they feel confident that with a continuance of God's blessing the future prospects will be increasingly prosperous and useful.
