

## CONSTITUTION.

### I.—NAME.

"The Adult Deaf and Dumb Mission of Victoria."

### II.—OBJECTS.

- 1.—To provide the means for religious worship and instruction for the adult deaf and dumb of Victoria.
- 2.—To visit the deaf and dumb in their homes, especially when sick or in distress.
- 3.—To assist the deaf and dumb of good character in obtaining suitable employment.
- 4.—To provide technical and other education for the adult deaf and dumb.
- 5.—To give pecuniary assistance to adult deaf and dumb who are in need.

### III.—MEMBERSHIP.

Every subscriber of 10s. and upwards shall be a member of the Mission for the period of 12 calendar months from the date of his subscription, and every donor of £10 and upwards shall be a life member. Any annual meeting may upon the recommendation of the Committee elect as a life member any person, who, in the opinion of the meeting, shall have rendered signal service to the Mission.

### IV.—MANAGEMENT.

The management of the Mission shall be vested in a Committee, consisting of a President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Secretary, and twelve other members. They shall be elected annually, and shall hold office until the close of the annual meeting succeeding their election, or any adjournment thereof. They shall have full power to act, notwithstanding any vacancies in their number.

### V.—MEETINGS OF MEMBERS.

An annual meeting of members shall be held in Melbourne in the month of April, or as soon thereafter as circumstances will permit. At such meeting a report of the proceedings of the previous financial year shall be presented, together with an audited account of receipts and disbursements, and the officers and committee for the year thence ensuing shall then be elected. Special meetings of the members may be called by the Committee, and shall be so called upon a request in writing, signed by not less than twenty members.

### VI.—DUTIES AND POWERS OF COMMITTEE.

The Committee shall meet at least once a quarter, and three shall form a quorum. The minutes of each meeting shall be taken by the Secretary, and duly recorded in a book to be kept for that purpose. The Committee shall have power to fill up all vacancies which may occur in said Committee during their term of office, to appoint a Missionary, to make arrangements for the conduct of public worship, of Bible classes or other religious services, and to adopt and carry out any means deemed necessary to secure the objects of the Mission, and to increase its usefulness. The Committee shall also have power to make or amend by-laws for the regulation of their own proceedings, and for the guidance of the Missionary.

### VII.—ALTERATION OF RULES.

No alteration of rules or additions thereto shall be made except by a meeting of the members of the Mission, convened in accordance with Rule V. One month's notice of any intended alteration or addition not proposed by the Committee, shall be given to the Committee in writing. The Committee shall, not less than one week prior to the meeting at which any alteration or addition may be proposed, advertise notice of the intention to propose an alteration or addition in one newspaper published in Melbourne, and shall, from the date of such advertisement, furnish particulars of the proposed alteration or addition to any member requiring the same.

## ANNUAL REPORT

OF THE

## Adult Deaf and Dumb Mission of Victoria

FOR THE YEAR ENDING 31ST MARCH, 1907

THE Committee, having accomplished one of the chief objects of the Mission in the erection of a building where the deaf mutes may meet together, have now embarked upon a further enterprise in the establishment of a home and industrial farm, such as that which exists at Parafield, in South Australia, where those who are aged, infirm, or of weak intellect, and are therefore unable to maintain themselves, may find a home, and at the same time be able to contribute to their own maintenance by performing such duties on the farm or in the home as they are able.

During the twenty-two years of the existence of the Mission the Committee have had forced upon them the need of a Deaf and Dumb Asylum, where those who are advanced in years and those who have reached the age where the training given by the Victorian Deaf and Dumb Institution ceases, and yet are unable, through infirmity of mind or body, to maintain themselves, may find a shelter, and at the same time not be under the necessity of entering a benevolent institution, where they would be unable to converse with the other inmates through their deprivation of speech and hearing.

The Government have promised to give £2000 upon condition that a like sum is contributed by the public. The Committee are now engaged in the task of obtaining this sum. They have reason to be satisfied with the rate at which the money is coming in, taking into account the other calls which have recently been made on the

public purse; but at present the sums in hand and promised fall far short of the required sum.

In aid of the fund it is intended to hold a bazaar in the Melbourne Town Hall next June. To this end the Superintendent of the Mission, Mr. E. J. D. Abraham, has been holding a series of meetings in the suburban town halls, with a view of obtaining the assistance of the public. The Committee desire to express their gratitude to the Mayoresses and other ladies who are organising stalls and by gifts of money and articles evincing their sympathy with the proposed institution. The energy which they are displaying should ensure the success of the bazaar. The following promises to provide stalls have already been made by Ladies' Committees in various suburbs:—

Camberwell, Refreshments; Collingwood, Jumble; Richmond, Sweets; Footscray, Miscellaneous; St. Kilda, Miscellaneous; Malvern, Produce; Hawthorn, Cake; Caulfield and Elsternwick, Stationery and Post-cards; Deaf and Dumb, Fancy Work, &c.; Girls of Melbourne, Dolls and Toys. Further meetings are to be held in other suburbs, which it is expected will help in the movement.

Mr. Abraham has now completed his fifth year as Superintendent and Chaplain of the Mission, and the Committee desire to place on record their appreciation of the enthusiasm and ability which he has brought to bear on his work in all its departments, and the esteem in which he is held by the deaf mutes.

The Committee continue to pay due regard to the religious side of the work of the Mission, which, while affording to the deaf and dumb the opportunity of holding services and classes in their own language, is entirely unsectarian. It has always been a source of gratification to find how harmoniously they meet together without any dissension, notwithstanding the diverse doctrines which are held by the deaf and dumb in common with the different sections of the Christian Church, and notwithstanding the fact that successive Chaplains have also belonged to different denominations.

On the other hand, the benevolent aspect of the work continues to claim increasing attention in proportion to the natural increase in the number of deaf and dumb. The following instances in which material help has been afforded by the Mission will serve to illustrate

the need that exists for such an institution, and the benefits conferred on the adult deaf and dumb by the subscriptions of the public:—

- (a) Blind and deaf man—earnings supplemented by weekly grant sufficient to enable him to pay his way.
- (b) Deaf man, and almost blind—assisted in same manner as case (a).
- (c) Elderly deaf and dumb woman, a widow—small weekly pension.
- (d) Elderly paralytic deaf mute woman—small weekly pension.
- (e) Deaf and dumb young girl, consumptive, mother a widow—weekly grant sufficient to provide necessities.
- (f) Deaf and dumb man, unable through weakness to procure work at his trade—provided with light employment, by which he was able for three years, until his death, to maintain himself and widowed mother.
- (g) Deaf mute young woman, penniless, consumptive—maintained during illness, and funeral expenses paid at death.
- (h) Young woman who had fallen into temptation—taken from Institution for hearing, provided with clothes and employment; now with kindly and sympathetic people and doing well.
- (i) Deaf mute youth, who through imperfect intellect and isolation in country became ungovernable—employment procured with deaf mute farmer.
- (k) Deaf mute woman, who owing to isolation became weak of intellect and ungovernable—procured home in family of deaf and dumb. Is now under care of Mission, and progressing favourably.
- (l) Deaf woman who had to leave her employment through failing eyesight—clothed and maintained by Mission and friends whilst attending Eye and Ear Hospital. Now fully recovered and in a good situation.
- (m) Deaf man, long time out of work, wife and three children—Committee advanced sufficient money to enable him to purchase tools and buy materials to start in business in country. He is now earning sufficient to maintain himself and family.

(n) Deaf mute man of weak constitution, unable to do regular work—granted sufficient weekly to maintain himself when unemployed.

(o) Deaf mute woman—work procured for and fare paid to home in country on failure of health.

(p) Three deaf mute men, all married, two had no regular work for many years, the third disabled from following his trade by an accident. All now fully employed, and earning sufficient to maintain themselves and families by the "Stores" started with money advanced by the Mission Committee.

Many have been assisted into situations, while others are constantly being provided with temporary work, and loans in small sums are granted to those in immediate need.

It is a matter for regret that Mr. Edward Newbigin has found it necessary to relinquish the office of Hon. Treasurer, a position which he has filled ever since the foundation of the Mission in the year 1885, to its great advantage. Fortunately, however, he will continue to act as Vice-president, so that the Mission will still have the benefit of his advice and assistance.

Mrs. Jno. E. Muir, a deaf mute lady, has established a gratuitous painting class for the benefit of the female deaf mutes. A photograph of one of her paintings, which appeared in the last annual report, shows her to be possessed of considerable artistic ability. The members of her class evince great pleasure in their work, and her kindly and thoughtful endeavour to interest them in art, and enable them to profitably employ their leisure time, is greatly appreciated by them and by the Committee.

The Committee are glad to report that the deaf mutes whom they established in a business of selling goods from house to house, and who were referred to on a previous occasion, have made a success of the venture. Although they are not able to earn as much as they would if they had the power of hearing, and had regular employment in business, they at any rate make sufficient profit to enable them to maintain themselves and families decently. Care is taken to supply them only with useful articles, and the prices fixed are reasonable. It is therefore hoped that the public on whom they

call will patronise their wares. At the same time it is not superfluous to mention that they receive no pecuniary assistance from the Mission, so that in their case there is no room for complaint that they are unduly competing with those engaged in similar business, while at the same time being maintained by public charity.

In conclusion, the Committee have reason for satisfaction with the past progress of the Mission and the manner in which its work is now being carried on. While there is due supervision, the deaf mutes are left as far as possible to manage their own affairs as a body, so that they may become possessed of self-reliance and business ability. There is every ground to believe that they will continue, as at present, moral and industrious citizens of the Empire.

EXTRACTS FROM  
NINETEENTH ANNUAL REPORT  
OF THE  
DEAF SUB-COMMITTEE.

---

IT is most gratifying to record that the work has in every respect been steadily progressive. One of the most pleasing features of the year just closed was the generosity of the members who contributed to the needs of their fellows at Christmas and on other occasions. We are now in the third year of occupation at our building, and have learned to look upon it as our home, where we may meet for all purposes, educational and social, and where every deaf mute is welcomed, protected, and aided.

The past year has, however, not been without its sorrow and partings. Two of our members have crossed the bar, four have departed from this State, and several have had illness, &c.

There have also been cases of need, but in every instance the Mission Committee has removed the difficulty by rendering the needed assistance. At the present time all our members are in employment, and we know of no mute who is in want. We therefore feel and would publicly record that God is good to His little flock of afflicted ones, and that we would offer words of thanksgiving and gratitude for His loving kindness.

**Committee.**—We also desire to express heartfelt thanks to the Mission Committee for the sympathetic interest always manifested by them in us, and also for their thoughtful consideration of the wishes of the deaf and dumb.

**Benevolent.**—In no single instance where help has been asked for has it been refused. Employment has been procured for both sexes, and assistance rendered in numerous ways, the sick maintained while ill, the unemployed supported until fresh work has been obtained for them, and pensions allocated to the aged, infirm, and blind deaf.

**Educational.**—Lectures upon a variety of topics—history, travel, biography, science, humour, &c.—have been delivered during the year by Mr. E. J. D. Abraham and his staff of voluntary deaf workers. Classes in dressmaking and painting for women, conducted by Miss Murphy and Mrs. J. E. Muir respectively, have been well attended.

**Religious.**—As we are cut off from all ordinary provisions made for the spiritual good of the community at large by the various denominations, the work of our Mission would not be complete without some special provision for divine worship conducted in a language understandable to the deaf, and as it is inconceivable that anyone having the welfare of the deaf at heart would desire to introduce sectarian strife into our united and peaceful little community, the services conducted by our Chaplain are of an unsectarian character. Love God and your fellow-men with all your strength, and live a peaceful and pure life, is the substance of his most acceptable teaching, and so we, though brought up under the wing of various doctrines, worship together in unity of spirit and in truth.

**Bible Classes.**—Bible classes have been held, with a few exceptions, weekly on Thursday evenings. The attendance has averaged about twenty. In the absence of our Chaplain, the Services and Bible Classes have been taken by the following helpers:—Messrs. M. L. Miller, A. C., W. P., and J. E. Muir, R. H. Luft, E. Burke.

**Collections.**—The total amount of the contributions for the year reached £35. 12s. 10d. In addition to this amount, the congregation contributed £4 4s. 7d. to the Hospital Sunday Fund.

**Rally.**—Several rallies were held during the year, the third being the annual tea meeting of the Mission, held on the 22nd May, when the Lord Mayor of Melbourne, Rev. S. Hoban, and others, gave addresses. The fifth was held on the 9th October in honour of our Chaplain's fifth anniversary and Mr. J. E. Muir's birthday—attendance eighty-eight, thirty-seven being friends. The sixth took place on the 21st December, with an attendance of eighty and seventeen friends.

**Our Monthly Letter.**—Our Monthly Letter has now attained its third year of issue, and it has increased in interest and usefulness. Numerous letters have been received from our country cousins, expressing appreciation of the letters, and stating how anxiously they look forward to its coming, and how much they enjoy reading it. The circulation is now 230 copies monthly. The management of the Letter is in the hands of Messrs. E. J. D. Abraham, M. L. Miller, E. Smith, J. Boortz, and J. E. Muir, with other helpers, and the thanks of the whole deaf community is here accorded them for their untiring labour. Other States are now issuing Monthly Newsletters, with which we exchange, and by this means are kept well informed of all matters connected with the deaf of Australia.

**Library and Reading Room.**—Our book cases are gradually filling, thanks to the kindness of friends of the Mission. In addition to several smaller gifts, a donation of sixty-five volumes was made by Mr. and Mrs. E. Burke prior to their leaving Victoria for New Zealand. The members have taken every advantage of the opportunities afforded, both by the plentiful supply of current literature on the reading tables and the lending Library. The Sub-Committee desire to place on record the valuable services rendered to the Library by our esteemed Librarian, Mr. M. G. B. Mortimer, who has held the position for four years, and has also been always willing and ready to assist in a most practical manner. His Assistant-

Librarian, Mr. J. McLean, carried out his duty satisfactorily, and is hereby accorded thanks.

Saturday Night Gatherings.—The Saturday night gatherings have always been a very popular feature of our building, and, if anything, have grown in favour. They do much to promote good feelings between the old and the young, and, to quote the expression of a visitor, "is more like the weekly reunion of a large and happy family." The average attendance is about thirty, and the members of the Sub-Committee take charge in rotation.

Picnic.—Our Annual Cup Day Picnic was held at Mordialloc on the 6th November, and some seventy of us attended. A grant of £2 5s. from the Mission Committee enabled the Sub-Committee to invite the poorer members of the Mission to join the outing and partake of dinner and tea.

Bank.—The Outing Fund and Bank is still in a flourishing condition. The number of depositors increases year by year, and Mr. F. E. Frewin devotes an evening weekly to this special branch of the work. He is assisted by Mr. M. G. B. Mortimer.

Conclusion.—The Sub-Committee would strongly urge upon the members the absolute duty of taking an individual interest in the work of the Mission, by using their personal influence with all deaf mutes, both old and young, with whom they come in contact, and not rest until all our brethren are brought within the loving fold of our Mission. Every member, too, should remember it is his or her duty to be punctual and regular in attendance at all meetings and services. In connection with the church the deaf mute is always in touch with wherever he or she may be.

We conclude this report by uniting in rendering our humble and hearty thanks to Almighty God for His continued blessings, and to whom be all praise and glory now and for ever.


