


OF THE

Adult Deaf and Dumb Society

OF VICTORIA (INCORPORATED)

MARCH 31ST. 1927

The Board of Management, in submitting their Annual Report to members and subscribers of the Society, at the outset desire to give expression to the pleasure all feel because of the possibility now of bringing about the consummation so long cherished by our Deaf and Dumb people.

THE CHARITIES BOARD.

Last year, in presenting their report, the Committee regretted being still compelled to carry on the Society's work in temporary premises pending permission of the Charities Board to make a public appeal.

That permission has now been granted, and the month of September allocated to the Society for the purpose.

SOCIETY'S AIM.

The aims of the Society, so far as is humanly possible, is to provide our deaf and dumb citizens with the opportunities already made available to the normal. In thinking of the deaf and dumb, both as individuals and as a community, we must at all times remember that the loss of hearing isolates them.

WHAT DEAFNESS MEANS.

Fellow citizens travelling side by side with us in train and tram, working with many of us in factory and workshop, cannot hold intercourse without difficulty. A blind or lame man immediately compels our sympathy, but a deaf mute may pass us a hundred times without our being aware of his affliction. Yet it is thought the worst by many who have experienced both.

Helen Keller (blind and deaf) writing upon this subject said: "The problems of deafness are deeper

and more complex, if not more important, than those of blindness. Deafness is a much worse misfortune, for it means the loss of the most vital stimulus—the sound of the voice—that brings language, sets thoughts astir and keeps us in the intellectual company of man."

The blind and lame man can attend a university and listen to a course of lectures, and possibly attain the highest honours, may go to their town hall and listen to an organ recital, oration or concert, or to a banquet and participate in the enjoyment of music, speeches, etc., also take part in normal church services.

None of these public institutions are of service to the deaf and dumb; hearing being essential.

In matters of education and entertainment special provision must be made to enable them to benefit.

WHAT THE DEAF ASK FOR.

The means to do this is all the deaf and dumb people of this State ask for.

Not charity, not pensions, or advantages that are not already available to other citizens, but just equal opportunities of citizenship.—those which normal citizens already enjoy.

GROWING DEAF POPULATION.

With the increase of population the deaf and dumb have increased in numbers, and the provision previously made by the Society is to-day inadequate with the special need of other activities. The objective, therefore, of the special appeal is to obtain sufficient funds in one great effort to cover all requirements, giving them, as far as possible, those opportunities that are already ours.

THE CHURCH.

In designing the little church the architect has had to remember that the preacher must be seen, not heard; acoustic provisions, therefore, are of no consequence. There must not be any light behind the preacher, but plenty of light is necessary immediately in front and over him, so that every movement of face, lips, eyes and hands may be clearly seen. The seats in the church must be shaped and arranged so that each member of the congregation faces the preacher without having to turn or lift the head. The preacher must have ample space on the platform to enable him to "act" his sermon—the language being mainly one of gesture.

A PLEASING FEATURE.

A very pleasing feature in connection with the appeal for a little church for the deaf is the sympathy of the Churches.

Archbishop Lees, in a letter to the Clergy of his diocese, says: "I very heartily commend the appeal which Mr. Abraham is making on behalf of his splendid work amongst the adult deaf and dumb. It is desired to erect a chapel in which they will be able to worship with that inspiration which we all of us derive from a worthy building. I hope that no one will refuse to respond to so pathetic an appeal for so good a cause."

Bishop Cranswick, to the Gippsland Clergy: "I very warmly commend to you the earnest appeal from Mr. Ernest J. D. Abraham which accompanies this letter, and I hope you will feel able to give your advocacy to so worthy a cause. I feel sure the pathos of the appeal will touch your heart and that you will desire for our deaf and dumb fellow citizens that inspiration which we more fortunate people feel we need in the way of ornate Churches worthy of the worship of God."

The Bishop of Bendigo: "I endorse the Archbishop's letter."

Dean Tucker, to the Clergy of the Diocese of Ballarat (at present without a Bishop): "With all my heart I commend the appeal now being made for the provision of a chapel in which our adult deaf and dumb brethren may worship God together. . . . I remember the loneliness of the deaf mute. Shut out from all beautiful sounds, unable to converse with the freedom and comprehensiveness of the spoken word, his inner life is spent very much alone. . . . One of the ways in which we can serve him is by giving him a worthy House of Prayer in which he may enjoy a common worship in that way which makes it possible for a congregation of the deaf and dumb to join together in prayer and praise."

The Bishop of St. Arnaud writes at the foot of Dr. Lees' letter: "Very cordially do I endorse the foregoing." While the Archbishop's letter was sent to the Clergy of the Diocese of Wangaratta, Bishop Armstrong's successor having not been appointed.

The Moderator, to the Ministers of the Presbyterian Church of Victoria: "I heartily commend this appeal to you. There could not be a more Christian object for our generosity than the erection of a church for the deaf and dumb. You and I, who have our hearing, can form only a faint conception of what it means to be deprived of this sense."

The President of the Baptist Union of Victoria: "I cordially commend to the Ministers and Officers of our Churches this call for help, and trust that whatever steps can be taken to help this project will be sympathetically carried forward in the cause of our Lord and Master Jesus Christ."

Pastor Shipway, President Church of Christ, Victoria: "The appeal for a little chapel for these unfortunate people, we feel sure, will touch your heart, and appeal also to the hearts of the people of your congregation. We express the hope that you, through your Official Board, will give your people the opportunity to present their practical support towards this worthy proposal."

The appeal is earnestly commended by the Chairman of the Congregational Union of Victoria.

The appeal is approved by the President of the Methodist Conference.

VOCATIONAL WORKSHOP.

If our deaf and dumb people are to keep pace with the rest of the community, then some form of vocational training must without delay be furnished. There is quite a large number of intelligent deaf men who having lost their hearing in youth or later have, because of the loss of this sense, become unfitted for the vocation they had been trained to, and are compelled to take any kind of job offering, leaving them without prospects and hope.

Parents, because of straitened financial conditions in the home, have not been able to give their deaf children a start in life by beginning at the bottom, but have been compelled to send them where the highest wage is given to commence, resulting in, at a later period, their services being dispensed with because, unskilled, they cannot demand the wage their age insists upon.

There are others just from school, and still others from the country. All these could be trained, and would in a short time, under proper instruction, become skilled craftsmen capable of earning standard wages. Again, there are others still less fortunate, who are not so intelligent and need very careful handling, but who would in time at least maintain themselves. It is for this quite considerable section of our charge we propose to erect a Vocational Workshop with necessary equipment.

HOSTELS.

The natural corollary to the Vocational Workshop is, of course, the Hostel. Our deaf youth, whilst under training must be housed and maintained under advantageous conditions. Those who are not fortunate in their home-life will have the option of remaining as paying guests of the Hostel.

There will be a Hostel for our boys and young men, and another for our girls and young women. "Home from home" under expert and sympathetic supervision. The whole world of instructors has long since realised that the leaving school time is the most critical in all our lives—when influence for good or evil is most easily made and is most lasting.

CENTRAL INSTITUTE AND CLUB HOUSE.

Here the secondary educational and social work of the Society will be carried on together with the various agencies for employment, advice, etc., containing offices, large assembly hall, class room, library, ladies', reading, and billiard rooms, kitchen, quarters for officer in charge, etc.

ADULT DEAF CENTRE.

The Centre, with all its varied activities, continues to grow in popularity, especially with the young people, and on special nights not only the hall, but the whole building, is crowded.

FARM COMMITTEE.

With the object of relieving Mr. Abraham of some of his onerous duties, a Committee has been formed to supervise the Farm, consisting of Messrs. Geo. Vial, Chairman; J. Dudley, S. L. Massina, T. Purves and G. Brown, with the Principal.

DEAF COMMITTEE'S REPORT.

The subscribers and friends of the Society will find, in the Deaf Committee's report, much interesting detail of the actual work accomplished during the year in and connected with their central meeting place, which at present stands for everything to the deaf, from Church to Club House.

INVITATION TO SUBSCRIBERS.

The Board feels the necessity of emphasising what our Society means to the deaf and dumb. All that it means can only be fully realised by a visit to Jolimont

Square, and they earnestly ask supporters and enquirers to come and see. Visitors are especially invited to the Saturday evening socials.

THE COUNTRY DEAF.

The Society is always mindful of the needs of the country deaf. By means of a little publication, which is ever welcome, and by our Country Missioner-Collectors, they are always kept in touch. The hostels will be of great service to the country deaf on their visits to Melbourne for special hospital advice or when seeking employment.

We desire to express our appreciation of the valuable services rendered by our honorary medical officers, Drs. W. J. Craig and F. May. To the subscribers and friends of the Society we extend our thanks for their support, by the aid of which we are enabled to carry on this important work.

EXTRACTS FROM THE
39th Annual Report of the Deaf
Committee

In placing before you the 39th Annual Report and Balance Sheet for the year ending March 31st, 1927, your Committee trust that you will experience the same satisfaction as has been the case in previous years in the general improvement of the Deaf Community.

Your Committee have the honour and pleasure in again recording their appreciation of the valuable services rendered the Society and its deaf members by the members of the General Board of Management during the year just passed.

Divine Services have been conducted every Sunday morning and evening throughout the year by our Chaplain, Mr. E. J. D. Abraham and the Missioner, Mr. J. M. Johnston. Mr. R. H. Luff and Mr. J. Gibson, of Adelaide, have also officiated, and Majors Amos and Drury, of the Salvation Army, conducted service on one occasion, when the Principal interpreted.

On the occasion of the **Harvest Thanksgiving Services**, on 27th March, 1927, the Church was decorated with gifts of fruit, vegetables and flowers from members of the congregation. The Chaplain officiated at both services. And on Hospital Sunday (October 24th) when the offertory was £9/2/6.

An innovation was made at a few of the evening services by the exhibition of sacred cinema pictures. The pictures were preceded by short sermons by the Chaplain. The attendance at these picture evenings was very large. The Sacrament of the Lord's Supper was administered on four occasions. Many of our younger members now participate.

The offertory for the year was £66/6/7.

The Thursday evening Scripture Classes and Lecturette classes were not so well attended as during the past few years, but latterly there has been a most satisfactory increase.

The social side of the Society has received continuous and careful attention, and the quarterly rallies are most popular of all.

A dinner was given to the members of the successful Lacrosse Club by the Committee on the evening of the final match, August 14th.

A very pleasing Welcome Home Social was extended to our Society's Hon. Secretary, Mr. R. J. Oehr, on the 20th September.

Another Welcome Home Social to Messrs. W. A. Paterson and A. W. Sutherland, who returned from a trip to Great Britain and Europe.

An impromptu Welcome Social to Mr. J. Paul and his wife (of Aberdeen, Scotland), who were in Melbourne for a day, on their way to take up Mission work in Queensland, on 28th February, 1927.

And an immensely successful Dinner to Mr. Ernest J. D. Abraham on the 28th October, to celebrate his 25th anniversary as Principal of the Adult Deaf and Dumb Society. A presentation was made to him by the Victorian Deaf of a gold watch and chain suitably engraved. The meeting was presided over by the ex-Hon. Secretary of the Society, Mr. H. Sumner Martin, and Messrs. E. R. Peacock and G. G. Mercy (ex-Chairman of the Society) addressed the gathering.

About seventy members attended the annual picnic at Mordialloc on Cup Day.

During the year a series of lectures was delivered mostly after the Scripture classes. The subjects were varied, interesting and of considerable educational value.

A very beautifully illustrated lecture on "Japan" was given on the evening of 2nd September by Mr. Robert Service.

The Kodak (Aust.) Pty. Ltd. gave an exhibition of pictures from a baby cinema machine on 16th September, and the firm of "Pathé's Cinema Machines" gave an exhibition of its three types of cinema machines.

The cinema machine purchased by the General Board has proved a popular acquisition, resulting in many pleasant picture nights.

The Women's Guild is still in a flourishing condition, and meetings are held regularly every three weeks. At present free painting lessons are given to members of the Guild by Miss Cooper, who reports that progress is being made by members of her class.

The Men's Guild has had one of the most successful years in its history. Its membership roll shows 50

names, and its syllabus was most excellently got up. As a diversion from the usual lectures and papers, visits were paid to various industrial concerns where members were able to gain first-hand knowledge of the workings, which otherwise they could not obtain understandingly from lectures.

The Library continues to be well patronised. During the year many new and secondhand books were added to the shelves. The donors were Mrs. Saltman, Mr. Moore (per Miss Mahoney), Mrs. E. Smith, Mrs. F. Johnson, Mr. R. H. Luff, Mr. Vial, Miss A. Graham.

The Winter Season Billiard Tournament maintained its popularity amongst the players.

The Saturday Night Socials continue to be crowded by the younger section of the Deaf community.

Our Monthly Letter, although more than ever popular with the country Deaf, for various reasons could only be issued as a bi-monthly during the past year.

The Workers' Club is still doing useful work, and the members have undertaken the work connected with many functions during the year, and is more popular than ever, due mainly to the active interest of Mrs. Pierce, who was elected Hon. Secretary at the annual meeting of the Club held in August, 1926. The membership thermometer rose rapidly until it passed all previous records—112.

The Xmas Treat given to the inmates of the Blackburn Home and Farm by the Club was very much enjoyed by the guests. The helpers were very happy to be able to add a little brightness to our less fortunate fellow-deaf.

A very successful and enjoyable Social was held at the Centre on the evening of Thursday, March 10th, 1927.

The annual picnic of the Workers' Club was held at Portarlington per S.S. "Courier," when 106 members thoroughly enjoyed the outing on Eight Hours Day, April 4th.

The Committee regret the loss of their Treasurer, Mrs. Holmes, who has gone to live in Queensland. Mrs. Holmes held this position for upwards of seven years, and was always ready and willing to give her services whenever required. Mrs. Frewin (President) and Mrs. Gladman (Acting Hon. Sec.) have carried on the work with the loyal help of the Committee since.

The Outing Fund and Bank is still improving. Deposits amount to £579/1/5, withdrawals £426/1/6,

present balance in hand £487/11/3. Thanks are tendered to Mr. R. H. Luff (Manager) and Mr. J. M. Johnston (Sub-Manager).

Enthusiasm is high amongst our sport-loving Deaf. The Lacrosse Club is still fortunate in having so fine a combination of players, that the No. 1 team came home winners of the "Junior A" premiership and the 2nd team, with a late run, managed to reach the third position.

The Cricket Club, which entered the V.J.C.A. Competition was a complete failure. The team went to Adelaide to defend the "E. J. D. Abraham Shield," and lost it to New South Wales Deaf.

Improvement is noticeable in the Tennis Club. Thirteen matches with outsiders were arranged during the year, and our team came out with as many wins as losses.

In conclusion, the Committee appeal to members to devote the best of their energies to the welfare of the Society, and also to show their gratitude and appreciation to the co-workers and all who have helped to achieve such a happy state of progress. The Committee desire to tender grateful thanks to the members for the able assistance rendered during the year, and trust the same loyalty and cheerful co-operation which exists at present will long continue.
