

## Annual Meeting of the Adult Deaf and Dumb Society

The annual meeting of the Deaf and Dumb Society of Victoria was held in the Melbourne Town Hall on June 6th, 1929. The Lord Mayor presided over a large attendance.

The annual report recorded satisfaction at a year of exceptional usefulness, but expressed the opinion that it had been one of the most trying in the annals of the Society, and for the time being much-needed additions for the housing and accommodation of the Society's varied activities had been held in abeyance. The problem of the employment of the deaf yearly became more accentuated and difficult of solution. Some were able to secure work without assistance, but many were not. Vocational training could not be too soon introduced; too many were, through force of circumstances, finding themselves in unsuitable occupations, and still more at the end of a blind alley. For the slow and backward vocational training of some kind was essential if they were to prevent them from becoming a permanent charge upon the public. The alternative to the Society providing special training was to board them while under instruction at ordinary vocational training schools. The financial statement was a matter for regret. For the first time in thirty years the Board was faced with a heavy deficit in the maintenance account, and there was still a debt of £11,000 on the Jolimont property, and the need for buildings to house the Society's many activities grew more acute every year.

The balance sheet showed that the receipts for the year ended 31st March, 1929, totalled £5888, and the expenditure £7222. The main sources of income were: Subscriptions and grants, £2947; rents, £1162; Farm and Homes' receipts, £1431. The main items of expenditure were: Salaries, £1644; Farm and Home expenditure, £2488; earnings of deaf mute employees and their travelling expenses, £955.

Moving the adoption of the report and balance sheet, the Lord Mayor expressed gratification at the progress the Society had made during the 45 years of its existence. The Society now catered for practically all the adult deaf and dumb in this State. The only matter for concern in regard to the activities of the

Society during the year was that expenditure had exceeded income, but this had been due to extra costs inseparable from the work of all institutions at this period, when the high cost of living and industrial troubles had interrupted the usual flow of subscriptions. The community was indebted to the Board of Management for the fine work it voluntarily did on behalf of those not able to help themselves. (Applause)

Mr. E. R. Peacock, president, seconded the motion, and declared that although the year's finances had not been as favourable as they might have been, the Society had good assets, particularly the head-quarters building at Jolimont, and the property at Blackburn. Some people seemed to think that if finances were not too good the Board should sell these assets and make a profit, but he emphasised it was the declared policy of the Society not to sell its assets. The Board was not a trading concern, but the trustee of the money subscribed by a generous public for a specific purpose. (Hear, hear.) He paid a warm tribute to the work and enthusiasm of the Principal, Mr. E. J. D. Abraham, and added that the day was coming when the Society would have to engage subordinates to carry on the grand work of Mr. Abraham, and thus release Mr. Abraham for the work of national secretary for Australia. Several inter-State societies needed the advice and guidance of an experienced and capable organiser such as Mr. Abraham. (Applause.)

The motion was carried.

Mr. A. L. Lonsdale, of the New South Wales Society, briefly addressed the meeting, paying a tribute to the excellent manner in which the Victorian Society was managed.

An address, signed by 200 deaf and dumb folk, was presented to the chairman, expressing appreciation of the work of the Board and loyalty to the Society.

Members of the Board expressed gratification at this tribute, and said it would encourage them to still better efforts.

MARCH 31st, 1929

Whilst recording with great satisfaction a year of exceptional usefulness in the work for the deaf and dumb, the year just passed was one of the most trying in the annals of our Society, and for the time being the much needed additions for the housing and accommodation of the Society's varied activities have had to be held in abeyance.

The needs of the adult deaf and dumb were recently brought to the attention of the House of Lords, when Lord Charnwood said: "Terrible as the situation of the deaf is, it does not immediately appeal to the compassion of everyone as is the case in regard to the blind," and the Duke of Montrose said: "That the deaf man is, perhaps, cut off from the world more than the blind man." Speaking at a public meeting, Mr. F. G. Barnes, M.A., forty years a teacher of the deaf, said: "My experience has taught me that the public does not realise what an appalling calamity is deafness and dumbness. If they did, much more attention would be paid to those suffering from this condition. Whereas people are always sympathetic towards, and willing to help, the blind, it frequently happens that the deaf, who are very much more socially isolated on account of their affliction, are neglected." Dr. Johnson, in 1773, referred to deaf-mutism as one of the most desperate of human calamities. The disability of the deaf and dumb is not obvious like blindness, but very real, because, as in no other affliction, it isolates; it makes those so afflicted a community apart, compelling special provision, hence the object of this Society is to give these people opportunities to participate, and guidance to the things of life so easily attainable by the hearing, but so difficult of attainment by those deprived of hearing.

The method of the Society in dealing with their charge may be summarised in a sentence. It is to take the youth of both sexes when they leave school and

endeavour to place them in suitable employment side by side with normal people and where the subject shows signs of undeveloped mentality, or for other reasons unfitted for competitive employment, they are admitted to our Blackburn Home, where an effort is made to train them to concentrate and, if possible, contribute toward their maintenance.

There are two sides to the Society's work. Provision for the deaf and dumb who are able to maintain themselves, and the section that are more or less dependent.

The general depression and unemployment have brought about a serious depletion of our funds, which means a bigger demand upon our resources, whilst our income from annual subscriptions has dropped considerably.

Again there has been an increasing demand upon the time of our officers in the rendering of immediate assistance, for when there is a general absence of employment the deaf and dumb are amongst the most serious sufferers.

Our headquarters at Jolimont Square is the central rallying place for all deaf mute activities, where the spirit of self-help is at all times encouraged.

#### OUR BLACKBURN HOME.

At the Society's Blackburn Home, the policy of the Board of Management is to admit all deaf mutes who are unable by reason of other affliction, mental or physical, to maintain themselves. Here are housed the blind deaf, aged, infirm, and mentally defective. The majority are occupied in the cultivation of flowers, the care of the kitchen garden and poultry. In addition to the inmates the whole of the employees on the farm are also deaf mutes. Our heavily handicapped family now number 40, and are contented and cheerful. With the exception of minor ailments, the health of the inmates has been good. Many improvements have been introduced and appreciated by the inmates, especially in the domestic arrangements. A sitting-room for the aged and infirm apart from the mental cases is much needed, also a recreation-room, where the younger inmates may enjoy their leisure.

#### PERSONAL ELEMENT.

The work of the Society is very largely of a confidential nature, the expert officers are continually occupied with the giving of advice and assistance in private and domestic matters, which not infrequently

take days, even weeks to adjust, and although this work is of paramount importance and absorbs a large percentage of the time of our officers, it is not in the best interest of the deaf mutes, who confide their difficulties to our keeping, that particulars should be given outside.

Members of the staff frequently accompany the deaf to hospitals, medical men, legal advisers, etc., explaining their cases and acting as interpreters.

#### EMPLOYMENT.

The problem of the employment of the deaf yearly becomes more accentuated and difficult of solution. Some are able to secure work without assistance, but many are not. Vocational training cannot be too soon introduced; too many are, through force of circumstances, finding themselves in unsuitable occupations, and still more at the end of a blind alley.

For the slow and backward, vocational training of some kind is essential if we are to prevent them from becoming a permanent charge upon the public. The alternative to the Society providing special training is to board them whilst under instruction at ordinary vocational training schools.

The Board acknowledge with appreciation the courtesy of the Chief Commissioner of Police and the officers in charge of Courts in giving the Society's officers the opportunity to interpret whenever cases in which deaf mutes are concerned come before the various Courts.

#### THE SOCIAL SIDE.

The social life of the Society has, despite the many difficulties, maintained interest and served useful purpose in the life of the members. Many happy functions have been held and well attended. It is very gratifying to see so many of our country visitors and friends rallying at the Centre and taking full advantage of the facilities provided whilst on a visit to Melbourne.

The cinema plays a big part. Every Thursday evening one or two films are screened for the benefit of the members, and to the following firms we are indebted for a continuous weekly supply of films free, for which we thank them: Australian Film Co., Metro Goldwyn Mayer Co., and Universal Film Co.

A cinema machine was recently purchased for our Blackburn Home to help gladden the lives of the inmates there.

Our headquarters at Jolimont Square and the Home and Flower Farm at Blackburn are open to the public. Every day is a visiting day, and subscribers and sympathisers of the work are earnestly invited to pay both institutions a visit.

#### CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEAR DINNER TO INMATES.

The inmates of the Blackburn Home spent a very happy Xmas and New Year. The General Board of the Society distributed Xmas presents to all, and for the New Year an added treat was given by Mrs. J. E. Muir and Mrs. Damman.

#### HOSPITAL SUNDAY COLLECTION.

Again the Hospital Sunday collection at our Church showed a very fine spirit among our members. The amount sent in was £9/11/-.

#### A BRIGHTER YEAR.

Everything points to a brighter year before us. A united effort is being made to bring all the activities up to the standard of our best years, and the management has every confidence that those ambitions will be realised. But it will mean a lot of work, for the standard was a very high one.

#### CHURCH SERVICES.

Church services are held in the finger and sign language every Sunday morning and evening at Jolimont Square, every afternoon at Blackburn, and on alternate Tuesdays at Geelong.

#### FINANCE.

Our financial statement is our one regret. For the first time in thirty years the Board is faced with a heavy deficit in the maintenance account, and there is still a debt of £11,000 on the Jolimont property, and the need for buildings to house the Society's many activities grows more acute every year.

#### WOMEN AND GIRLS.

Much of the time of Miss E. Empson, the Assistant Secretary and Assistant Treasurer, is devoted to personal efforts on behalf of our women and girls; the finding of employment, visiting the sick and attending at hospitals, etc., as interpreter.

Mrs. F. E. Frewin has also rendered helpful service as President of the Deaf Women's Guild and Workers' Club.

#### MEN AND BOYS.

Almost daily the Missioner, Mr. Johnston, has been occupied in the interest of the men and boys, seeking work for them and catering for the recreational side of this work. In the latter he has much support from the younger men, who are showing their capabilities in the right way.

Amongst the events annually looked forward to by the deaf is the trip down the Bay. This pleasant outing was attended by over 100 of our members, which is made possible through the kindness of Mr. Evans, of the Bay Steamers Ltd., who for the last seventeen years has granted free passes for the trip. Our thanks are also due to a number of ladies and gentlemen for donations toward the expenses of the day.

We regret to record the death of two former Hon. Treasurers, Mr. G. G. Haldane and Mr. H. L. Waters. Both these gentlemen were enthusiastic workers.

The Board recognise and fully appreciate the work of the various deaf Secretaries and Committees throughout the past year. It is a pleasure to see the enthusiastic way in which the younger members are developing and proving themselves efficient in the work required of them.

A branch of the work has been opened at Geelong, and so pleased are the local deaf that every one in the district is attending the meetings held fortnightly at the Rotary Club's Room, lent gratuitously by that Club. During the coming year an effort will be made to get into more constant touch with the country deaf and to establish branches where a sufficient number can be got together.

One of the features that gives the Board of Management exceptional pleasure is the Deaf Mutes' Bank. They have to their credit the sum of £680/14/2.

Further detailed information of the minor work as carried on at the Centre will be found in the Deaf Committee's report. Here it will be seen that the work is very much on the same lines as at any Church for the normal, with their religious, educational and social activities.

The Board wishes to put on record their thanks to a fellow member, Mr. A. E. Atherton, for the gift of a drinking fountain for the Centre.

#### CONFERENCE.

During the year a Conference of Principals of Adult Deaf and Dumb Societies was held in Hobart,

and as the subjects dealt with and decisions arrived at are of general interest they are published at the end of this report.

#### APPRECIATION AND THANKS.

It is with gratitude the members of the General Board record their appreciation of the support given by all who have made possible the carrying on of the work of the Society in donating so generously to the Fund.

To the Committees, Officers and Society's officials both at Jolimont Square and Blackburn Farm.

To Drs. W. J. Craig and F. May for the care and attention they have given to the Home inmates.

## CONFERENCE OF PRINCIPALS OF ADULT DEAF AND DUMB SOCIETIES OF AUSTRALIA.

In sending forth the resolutions passed at the Conference of Principals of the Adult Deaf and Dumb Societies of Australia, held at Hobart on the 26th and 27th of December, 1928, the President, Professor Morris Miller, wrote:—

"I would take the opportunity of expressing my personal opinion that I consider conferences of this character to be most beneficial for the welfare and advancement of the adult deaf societies in Australia, and I would strongly urge the several Boards of Management to do everything possible to foster these periodical gatherings of responsible officers as well as of the adult deaf and dumb. I myself gathered a great deal of information of importance which will be most useful to me in my presidential office. Whether the conferences should be held annually is really a matter of finance; but every effort should be put forth to convene them at least biennially, in the hope that an effective Australian organisation for the advancement in life of the adult deaf and dumb may be ultimately formed. When one considers the isolation of the deaf mutes in the smaller States, as well as the comparative fewness of the numbers in the larger States, in relation to the imperative needs of an enlarged social intercourse to obviate the heavy handicaps arising from their cut-off from language contact with their fellow citizens, it behoves the governing authorities to bring about the assemblage of the deaf in larger and wider communities for their mutual advancement in all directions, making for their increased efficiency as worthy citizens of the Commonwealth. Indeed, in these days when so much is being made of the Adult Education Movement, the adult deaf should be privileged to enjoy their portion, and I am altogether unconvinced that it may not be a question for both Federal and State Governments to assist this endeavour to unite the adult deaf in a common bond for their educational and spiritual progress, and so overcome the geographical barriers of separation which do not seriously affect their fellows in the more densely populated countries of Europe and America.

"May I also add that it would be a good thing if those responsible officers of the deaf and dumb schools of the States could also meet under similar conditions

to confer with their colleagues representing the adult organisations."

Professor Morris Miller concluded by commanding the resolutions to the serious consideration of all Boards of Management of Adult Deaf and Dumb Societies.

The resolutions were:—

(1) That the Principals meet annually for the purpose of conference and interchange of ideas.

(2) That it be a recommendation that School Superintendents meet in conference at the same time and place and confer with the Principals of adult societies.

(3) That an organised conference of deaf and dumb be held biennially at the same time as the cricket shield is competed for.

(4) **Motor Licences.**—That this Council is of opinion that deaf-mutism should not be in itself a disqualification for obtaining a motor driver's licence, and that in cases of doubt, the licensing authority be recommended to confer with the Principal of the Adult Deaf Society in that State.

In connection with the above, it is suggested that a side mirror be fixed on motor vehicles driven by deaf drivers.

(5) **After care.**—With a view to the after-care and future career of pupils leaving deaf schools, this Council recommends that Principals of schools notify the names and home addresses of such children to the Principals of Adult Societies three months before the pupils are finally discharged.

A copy of this resolution to be forwarded, through the Boards of Management, to Directors of Education.

(6) **Statistics of Deaf and Dumb.**—That Messrs. Abraham, Hersee and Redman be authorised to confer with the Commonwealth Statistician with reference to the census and statistics of deaf persons in Australia.

(7) **Uniformity of Signs.**—In view of the fact that New South Wales is the only State to use their method of figure sign language, it is considered that they should adopt the figure signs as used in the other States of the Commonwealth.

(8) **Single - Handed Alphabet.**—That schools not using the double-handed alphabet should be asked to teach, in addition to the single-handed alphabet, the two-handed method.

(9) **Uniformity of Names of Adult Deaf Societies.**—That, in view of the intellectual and moral standing of the deaf and dumb in Australia, and their organisation into self-governing societies, it is desirable that there should be uniformity of title, and, as these societies have outgrown the term "Mission," it is considered the application of this term to these societies is obsolete, and we suggest the title of "Adult Deaf and Dumb Society" be used by all.

(10) **Committee of Investigation.**—That the Principals act as a Committee of Investigation to report to a later conference, or, failing such, to the Boards of Management, on the following problems:—

- (i.) Vocational training of normal deaf.
- (ii.) Care of mentally defective deaf-mutes.

(11) **Form of Service and Hymnal.**—That the mainland Principals act as a committee, with Mr. Abraham as convenor, to draw up a form of service and hymnal for services for the deaf.

## EXTRACTS FROM THE 41st Annual Report of the Deaf Committee.

To the Members of the Adult Deaf Congregation.  
Ladies and Gentlemen,

It gives us, the Deaf Committee, great pleasure to report on the activities of the "Centre" for the past twelve months. We are still plodding quietly and steadily on, and although unable to report as much progress as looked forward to at the beginning of the year, we can safely say we have not gone backwards.

We feel that we cannot allow this opportunity to pass without recording our high appreciation of the services rendered by the General Board.

Religious services have been regularly conducted on Sunday mornings and evenings throughout the year by Messrs. E. J. D. Abraham (Principal) and J. M. Johnston (Missioner), and on several occasions by Mr. R. Lambert. The attendance, we regret to say, was not so satisfactory as we would have liked.

Communion Services were held as usual in April, July, October and January, when the Sacrament was administered by Mr. Abraham.

The offertory for the year was £67/12/6.

The Hospital Sunday Services were held on the 28th of October, 1928, when the congregation contributed a sum of £9/11/- towards the Lord Mayor's Fund.

The Harvest Thanksgiving Services were held on the 10th of March, 1929, when a fine display of greenery, vegetables, and fruit, etc., was made.

The Thursday Evening Scripture Study Classes and Lecturettes were regularly held, with the addition of cinema pictures. Our best thanks are due to: Australasian Film Co., Metro-Goldwyn Mayer Film Co., and Universal Film Co. for their continued generosity in allowing free use of their films.

Saturday Night Recreation Meetings were increasingly popular. With a view of brightening up these evenings, the Deaf Committee had twelve card tables

made, and many pleasant evenings were spent with cards. The billiard table has proved a constant source of recreation and enjoyment, and a tournament was held, as usual, last winter.

The Rallies have been held quarterly, and there were a good number of Welcome Socials besides. The Social Sub-Committee supervised these functions, and are to be congratulated for their successful management. The hall has again and again proved to be totally inadequate to accommodate the crowds that attend these Rallies.

The Annual Picnic was held at Blackburn on Cup Day, November 6th, when a most enjoyable time was spent.

The Women's and Men's Guild meetings have been well attended, and many excellent papers and lectures were given.

The Deaf Workers' Club has accomplished much good, and we desire to express our deep appreciation to the Committee of the Club, who undertook the arrangements for catering at Rallies and Socials, and got up a Xmas Treat to the inmates of the Blackburn Home.

A Garden Party was held at Jolimont, under the auspices of the General Board, on the 16th of March, when a most enjoyable time was spent.

The popularity of lacrosse, cricket and tennis has been well maintained by the sport-loving Deaf Community. Unfortunately, these clubs failed to make any kind of show worth recording during the season. The most important happenings were the Lacrosse Club's trip to Adelaide in August, and the Cricket Club's trip to Hobart last Xmas.

The Hon. Manager (Mr. Johnston) reported a very satisfactory position of the Deaf Savings Bank. The Balance Sheet showed: £794/17/9 deposited during the year, and the withdrawals £758/4/5, leaving £36/13/4 to be added to last year's balance of £608/11/8, making a total of £645/5/-. The officials are to be heartily thanked for the able way the finances were managed.


