The Adult Deaf and Dumb Society of Victoria provides a special Institute for the Adult Deaf and Dumb, known as The Adult Deaf Mute Centre, Jolimont Square, Melbourne East.

Every effort is made to provide these doubly handicapped people—at our One Institution—with the same advantages as are enjoyed by hearing and speaking people in many associations.

The headquarters of the Society contain a Church, Social and Lecture Hall, Classrooms, Billiard Room, Library, Offices, etc. Here services, lectures and classes are regularly conducted in the language of the deaf and dumb by expert instructors. There are frequent socials and entertainments; also there the Deaf Lacrosse, Cricket, Tennis and Rambling Clubs hold their meetings.

We have an officer on duty from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily to assist in our activities of the Employment Bureau and Relief Agency. The Society also publishes its own newspaper. The mere fact of being deaf and dumb entitles all so afflicted to these advantages. It is open to all denominations.

For the Aged, Infirm and Blind Deaf and Dumb, there is a comfortable Home beautifully situated at Blackburn. For those who are Mentally Defective, as well as deaf and dumb, there is a Training Farm connected with this Home. This is another activity of the Adult Deaf and Dumb Society.

We believe there are many more in the State bearing these terrible afflictions, the relations and friends of whom have never heard of our Home.

FORTY-FIRST ANNUAL REPORT

OF THE

Adult Deaf and Dumb Society

OF VICTORIA (INCORPORATED)

MARCH 31ST, 1925

The Members of the Board of Management are pleased to be able to report that the Society, in all its branches of work, has maintained during the past year the high standard of efficiency to which it had previously reached. While expressing their appreciation to the Principal, Mr. E. J. D. Abraham, for the successful work accomplished, they feel that they may also congratulate the Subscribers on being supporters of a cause which is productive of so much usefulness.

ADULT DEAF MUTE CENTRE, JOLIMONT.

Last year the Board had the pleasure of reporting the purchase of Jolimont Square at a cost of £25,000. Of this amount, £14,000 has been paid, leaving a balance of £11,000 still owing upon the property.

The larger of the houses at Jolimont Square, known as "Red Court," has been altered and such additions made that for the past twelve months the whole of the activities of the Society, as originated and carried on at the old Centre in Flinders Street, were kept in full swing.

This is the administrative centre of the Society, where provision is made for Divine Worship (in the language of the Deaf and Dumb), also for the continuance of the Educational, Social and Benevolent work of the Institution. Nothing is being left undone as regards the immediate needs of the deaf and dumb, but the limitations of the building do not permit of the expansion of the work which we have for so many years realised as desirable.

The Board, however, was fortunate in securing a property upon which was a building readily made adaptable for the uninterrupted continuance of the work of the Society, whilst in the meantime plans could be considered and preparations made to raise funds for the proposed new buildings.

The alteration of the present "Centre," or Club House, has made available a spacious room which will accommodate about 200 people. This is being used as

a Church and lecture hall, also for meetings and socials. There are other rooms in use respectively as library and reading room, billiard room, managerial offices, and quarters for caretaker, etc.

On the recommendation of the Society's architects, Messrs. Gawler and Drummond, the tender for reconstruction lodged by Messrs Edwards and Callaway, contractors, was accepted, and the work completed at a cost of £1,389/17/-.

FUTURE OBJECTIVE.

The Members of the General Board are most anxious to complete the work which they for so many years have visualised, and now is made possible by the acquisition of this fine property—Jolimont Square.

A CHURCH, capable of seating about 300 people, and especially suited to the requirements of the finger and sign language, is estimated to cost about £3,000.

HOSTELS, one for deaf and dumb men, and one for deaf and dumb women, etc., it is assumed will cost a further £2,000.

A CENTRAL BUILDING.—It will be necessary to make alterations to an existing building for the purpose of providing a social hall, workshop, gymnasium, library and reading room, billiard room, offices and other quarters, which will probably cost another £10,000.

The cost of these buildings and alterations, together with the sum of £11,000 still owing upon the property, will make the total sum required at least £26,000.

THE EYE OUR ONE GATEWAY.

It is only necessary to draw attention to the fact, when it will be immediately recognised, that the absence of the senses of hearing and speech means the dependence upon the sense of sight for practically **everything** which goes to make life endurable to the deaf and dumb.

The deaf and dumb are educated through the eye. It is by this medium, assisted by the hands, that they are able to enjoy social intercourse and the few pleasures of life open to them; hence it has always been our aim to surround the deaf with conditions that appeal to the eye.

This all important fact will explain the purchase of the Blackburn and Jolimont properties, both of which are ideal for the purposes of the Society, and also why special provision is necessary.

At all ordinary public institutions—the church, the lecture hall, the theatre, the club dinner, the dance,

the social evening, music, and in general conversation, the sense of **hearing** is mainly depended upon. So that from all these public institutions (the very essence of life) **the deaf and dumb are shut out**. This fact cannot be too strongly or too often emphasised.

The loss of hearing isolates the deaf and dumb into a little community of their own, necessitating a substitute for speech, which had to be found, and it was found in the language of gesture in conjunction with the manual alphabet.

EDUCATIONAL AND BENEVOLENT.

The past year was one of the most difficult of recent years; one of the causes being an unusual strain upon the staff in connection with the unemployment of the deaf and dumb. "We have no unemployed" was for years the proud slogan of the deaf, and they justified that claim—to work side by side in factory and workshop, earn the same wage, and "carry on" in the same manner as do normal citizens, is the laudable aim of the deaf and dumb of this State. An ambition of which we have every reason to be proud. But with thousands of men in possession of their normal faculties out of work, it is not a matter of surprise that we have had members of our sorely handicapped community seeking employment also; yet never have we had more than three or four unemployed at any one time. In every instance of need we have been able to provide for those who sought assistance.

AIM.

But the aim of our Society is **constructive**. We are out to make desirable citizens of the whole of the deaf and dumb of this State. The Society will always provide the necessary relief for every indigent case, and is determined that no deaf mute shall, within its knowledge, be in want. Our work is essentially educational, and benevolent of necessity.

"Constructive" is the word best suited to clarify our aim, and we believe we have every reason for claiming success. Outside of their handicap—the loss of those precious gifts, hearing and speech—the deaf and dumb now compare most favorably with the average citizen of Victoria, spiritually, morally, physically—citizens realising their personal responsibilities.

Normal people attending deaf and dumb socials will find both education and inspiration. There is never anything lacking, except hearing and speech. Good fellowship, laughter, and spontaneous good will predominate.

BLACKBURN HOME.

Of course there is the other side. Modern civilisation has brought about wonderful provision for the dependent hearing population of the State—hospitals, asylums and homes for the suffering, insane, mentally defective, epileptic, blind, retarded, orphans, etc., etc.

As with the hearing, so with the deaf and dumb. There is a relative section similarly afflicted. We have our troubled and grief-stricken little world also—our insane, mentally defective, “unplaceable” and blind deaf mutes. These are comfortably housed in our Home at Blackburn, and even here, with people so terribly afflicted, there is to be found a measure of brightness and contentment. Everything possible is done by the Members of the General Board, the Principal, the Society’s officers, Committees and members to ensure the best of conditions possible.

HEALTHY RECREATION ENCOURAGED.

Last year the Members of the General Board, at the request of active and responsible members of the Society, loaned the Deaf Mute Athletic Club a sum sufficient to enable them to lay out a suitable ground at Blackburn for their lacrosse and cricket teams. The money was promptly repaid.

This year a similar appeal from the Tennis Club has been treated in like manner, the deaf-mute members being advanced the cost of the construction of a tennis court at Jolimont Square, which they have undertaken to refund in three years.

DEAF COMMITTEE.

The General Board has explicit confidence in its Deaf Committee. For upwards of twenty years they have been entrusted with the inner working of the Centre and the welfare of the members of the Society generally. Several of the Committeemen have been members and active workers from between thirty and forty years. The Principal is Chairman.

There are four deaf mutes on the General Board of Management, elected direct by the deaf mute members of the Society. Each Guild and Club has its own Committee. A fair insight into the activities of the Centre may be gathered from the extracts made from the Deaf Committee’s report.

OUR MISSIONER.

Reference was made in our last report to the appointment of a deaf young man, Mr. J. M. Johnston, as Assistant Missioner. The Board are satisfied that they have secured the services of the right man for

the special work entrusted to him. Mr. Johnston has been very successful in procuring employment and in the supervision of the younger members of the Society at their guilds and social gatherings. He is ever willing to render service on all occasions.

MR. M. L. MILLER.

Mr. M. L. Miller, who rendered so many years of faithful voluntary service to this Society, is still absent as the result of his long continued illness, and we desire to record our deep sympathy for him in the great trial he is going through. He did so much good work in the pioneer days of the Society that his help at this period is much missed.

APPRECIATION.

The Members of the General Board of the Society wish to record their appreciation of the services rendered by all Committees, officers, and the Society’s officials, both at Jolimont Square and Blackburn Farm.

We desire to again express our appreciation of the valuable services rendered by our honorary medical officers, Drs. W. J. Craig and F. G. Heyer; also to the subscribers and friends of the Society we extend our thanks for their support, by the aid of which we are enabled to carry on this important work.

THE PRINCIPAL.

The success and progress of the Society is largely the result of the constructive thought and activity of Mr. Ernest J. D. Abraham, and all will join in the wish that he may be spared for many years of service to this—his “life-work.”

EXTRACTS FROM THE
**37th Annual Report of the Deaf
Committee**

In presenting the 37th Annual Report and Financial Statement ending March 31st, 1925, we, the Deaf Committee, feel that our first words must be words of thanksgiving to God, by whose loving kindness so many blessings have been vouchsafed to us; also words of grateful appreciation for the kindly interest shown by the Members of the General Board in our welfare.

DIVINE WORSHIP.—The spiritual provision for the deaf during the past year has held first place in the work of the Deaf Committee. The Principal and Chaplain (Mr. E. J. D. Abraham) was responsible for the Evening, Special and Communion Services, and the Missioner (Mr. J. M. Johnston) officiated at the Morning Services, and conducted the Thursday Evening Scripture Class. The congregation has shown a broader outlook, contributing most generously to philanthropic work outside their own special sphere, and at the same time rendering still greater financial support to their own Church. The Church collections reached £71/3/10. At the Hospital Sunday Services, held on 26th October, 1924, the offertory was £10/10/-. Harvest Thanksgiving Services were held on 29th March, 1925.

CHURCH RALLIES.—The Quarterly Rallies maintained their popularity. There were crowded attendances at the Anniversary Rally (September 25th), the Christmas Rally (December 18th), and the "Altogether" Rally (March 21st). The King's Birthday Rally was dropped on account of the new Centre being in the hands of the builders.

SOCIALS.—The Old Deaf Pioneers of the Society were the guests of our Principal on the evening of 14th January at our new Centre, Jolimont Square, and the "Young Folk" on 3rd February. Two 21st Birthday Parties were held during the year. The first was in the form of a surprise party to Miss Thelma Stephens, and held on 14th May. The second was to Miss Iris Boortz, held on December 16th, 1924.

GARDEN PARTY.—To inaugurate the completion of our new Club House and the opening of the Tennis Court, a Garden Party was held at Jolimont Square on the 21st March. Notwithstanding the inclemency of the weather, there was a large attendance. Mr. E. R. Peacock, Vice-President of the Society, presided at the opening, and Mrs. J. E. Muir performed the opening ceremony at the Tennis Court. In the evening there was a crowded attendance, Mr. J. E. Muir presiding.

PICNIC.—The Annual Picnic on Cup Day (November 4th) was held at Mordialloc, when there was a much smaller attendance (50) than in former years.

SATURDAY NIGHTS.—The Social Gatherings on Saturday nights continue to be one of the most popular features, attracting large attendances.

MONTHLY LETTER.—"Our Monthly Letter" has now entered upon its 22nd year. Owing to the heavy demand upon the Principal's time in connection with the removal from Flinders Street to Jolimont Square, the building alterations and other extraordinary calls, the letter has been printed quarterly. Donations from 1/- upward, amounting to £7/5/6, toward the cost of production, have been received and acknowledged with grateful thanks. The cost of printing (over £20) was the largest item of expenditure of the Deaf Committee.

LIBRARY.—The Library and Reading Room is still well patronised by the deaf members, but there is a noticeable falling off in the lending department, no doubt through the absence of new books.

BILLIARD TOURNAMENT.—During the winter season a Billiard Tourney was again an attractive feature amongst the deaf men. The prizes were generously donated by our Principal, Mr. E. J. D. Abraham.

OUTING FUND AND BANK.—The bank continues to flourish. During the past year £256 was deposited, bringing the total to £466. The withdrawals amounted to £147/0/4, leaving a balance of £319/4/8.

WOMEN'S GUILD.—Under the able leadership of the President, Mrs. J. Pierce, the Women's Guild has had a very successful year. The lectures given and papers read maintain the high standard of the past. Much credit is also due to the Hon. Secretary, Miss Margaret Gibson, who has been untiring in her efforts to further the interests of the Guild.

MEN'S GUILD.—The report of Men's Guild shows steady progress. During the year popular lectures were given; also two debates, which proved very interesting. The Annual Picnic, held on Foundation Day at Beaumaris, was well attended and much enjoyed.

WORKERS' CLUB.—The Workers' Club is still doing good work. Among the many activities, a class was conducted by the President (Mrs. Gladman) every Saturday afternoon and evening, and members were very efficiently taught the art of paper flower making, the result of which helped to swell the funds of the Floral Fete. A good share of the catering arrangements during the year was successfully carried through by members of the Club.

RAMBLING CLUB.—The Ramblers' Club is still in existence, but has been quiet of late, due to the many activities of other clubs that required Saturday afternoons.

ATHLETIC CLUB.—**Lacrosse:** It is pleasing to record the continued healthy outlook of the Lacrosse Club. Owing to its consistent performances in previous seasons the Club was graded "Senior A" by the Victorian Lacrosse Association, and by its performance during the season it has justified its promotion. The Club just missed its chance in the final four; however, it is to be congratulated on its splendid effort.

The South Australian Deaf Lacrosse Team paid another call to Melbourne, and played their third Interstate match against the Victorian Deaf Team, and the result was in our Club's favor by 14 goals to 9.

Cricket: Owing to the desire of many players to devote their Saturday afternoons to the improvement of the Sports Ground at Blackburn, it was agreed not to compete in regulation matches this season.

Tennis: The Tennis Club is now in possession of a new asphalt court in Jolimont Square. Our fair sex will find plenty of enjoyment on Saturday afternoons, while the males devote their time to lacrosse and cricket. The new tennis court was officially opened on 21st March by Mrs. J. E. Muir during the Garden Party.
