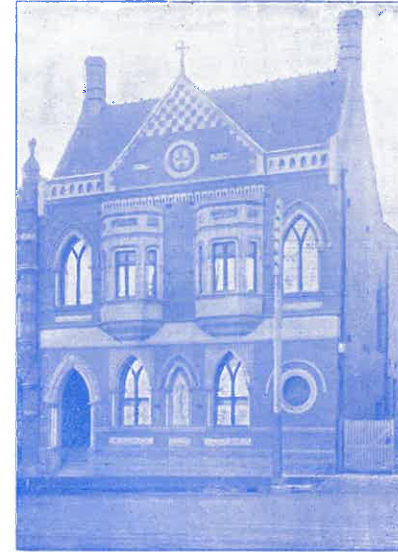

## The Adult Deaf and Dumb Building

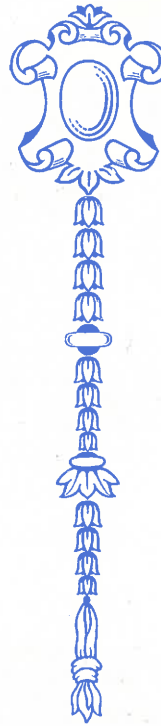
**I**S the rendezvous of the Deaf Mute population of **all** Sects in Victoria.

**Caters for all their needs**, providing Library, Reading Room, and Club Accommodation for both sexes.

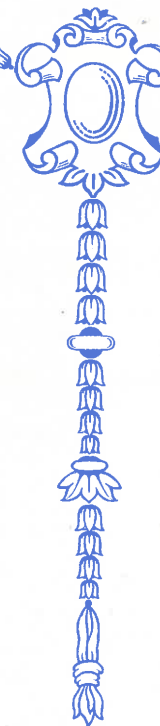
Public Worship, Lectures and Classes conducted in their own language.
