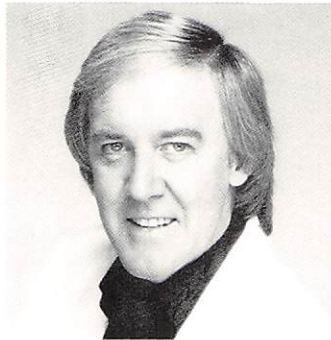


Julie Anthony OBE

As a recording artist and a star of concert, cabaret, stage and television Julie is in constant demand throughout Australia.

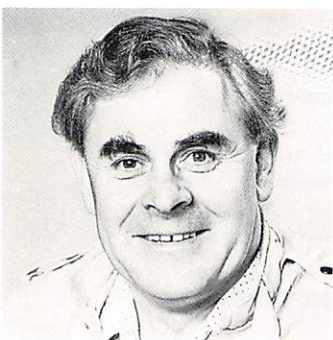
Barry Crocker

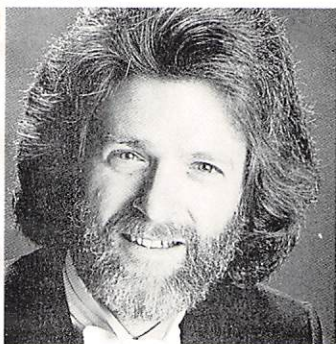
Brian Doyle

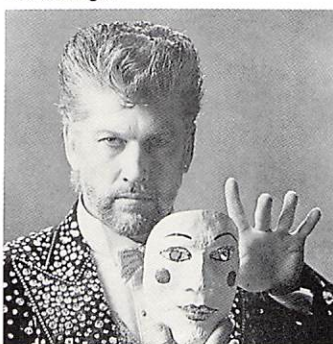
Keith Glover Compere
