

## HISTORICAL HIGHLIGHTS



- 1857 Lodge consecrated at Maldon, No. 1047, English Constitution.  
1861 Lodge moved to Vaughan.  
1871 Lodge moved to Newstead, became No. 745.  
1889 Lodge became No. 15 Victorian Constitution.  
1907 Present Lodge room purchased.  
1908 Complete set of Working Tools presented by Lodge St. George.  
1909 Lodge room flooded, organ, etc., destroyed.  
1910 Dr. Hill presented an organ.  
1913 Dr. Hill presented the Baton.  
1921 Perfect Ashlar presented by Mount Franklyn Lodge at Hiram.  
1927 Bro. Hawkey presented box for collars, etc.  
1938 Electric light installed.  
1940 Carpet presented by Metropolitan brethren.  
1942 Gavel made from natural material obtained in Palestine presented by Bro. C. Rankin.  
1971 Reconstruction of Lodge Rooms.
