The forthcoming campaign will be based on "W O R K".


It is not too early to start preparing for this Campaign and to begin praying and thinking about the role you play at work, as work comprises the main part of your life.

- 3. AS A REGION WE WILL ORGANIZE REGIONAL MEETINGS WITH THE AIM OF EXTENDING THE CAMPAIGN TO ALL YOUNG WORKERS.




THE SOFTBALL SEASON IS NOW IN FULL SWING AND COMPETITION IS STRONG IN ALL ZONES.


