CITY OF CAULFIELD LETTERS PATENT TRANSCRIPTION

TO ALL AND SINGULAR to whom these Presents shall come Sir Anthony Richard Wagner. Knight Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Garter Principal King of Arms. John Riddell Bromhead Walker, Esquire, Member of the Royal Victorian Order, upon whom he has been conferred the Decoration of the Military Cross, Clarenceux, King of Arms and Walter John George Verco, Esquire, Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Norroy and Ulster King of Arms Send Greeting!

Whereas Geoffrey Neill Doolan, Esquire, Bachelor of Laws of the University of Melbourne, Mayor of the CITY OF CAULFIELD in the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, did represent unto the Most Noble Bernard Marmaduke, Duke of Norfolk, Knight of the most Noble Order of the garter, Knight Grand Cross of the royal Victorian Order, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, upon whom was conferred the Territorial Decoration Earl Marshal and Hereditary Marshal of England and one of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, now deceased, that the Corporation of the Mayor, Councillors and Citizens of the City of Caulfield came into existence when the Town of Caulfield was proclaimed a City By Proclamation of the Governor of the State of Victoria on the Twenty – eighth day of May 1913 made in pursuance of the provisions of Section 16 and 36 of the Local Government Act 1903 of the Legislature of the said State of Victoria: that the Corporation of the Mayor, Councillors and citizens of the City of Caulfield is desirous of having armorial ensigns duly established with lawful authority and he therefore, as mayor of the said city and on behalf of the said Corporation did request the favour of His Grace's Warrant such Supporters and such device or Badge as we may consider fit and proper to be borne and used by the Corporation of the Mayor **councillors** and Citizens of the City of Caulfield on seals or otherwise according to the Laws of Arms / And forasmuch as the said Earl Marshal did by warrant under his hand and Seal bearing date the fifth day of September / 1974 authorise and direct us to grant and Assign such Armorial Ensigns accordingly Know Ye therefore that We the said Garter Clarenceux and Norroy Ulster in pursuance of his Grace's Warrant and by virtue of the Letters Patent of our several Offices to each of Us respectively granted do by these Presents grant and assign unto The Corporation of the Mayor, Councillors and Citizens of the City of Caulfield the arms following that is to say: **Purpale Argent and Gules Barry Lion passant counterchanged** and for the Crest **Out of a Mural Crown or a Dragon's Head / erased Gules within an annulet compony Or and Azure**, Mantled Gules doubled Argent: And We do further grant and assign the following Device or badge that is to say: **Within an Annulet compony Ore and Azure on a Mural Crown Gules a Chestnut horse passant saddled and bristled proper**: And by the Authority aforesaid I the said Garter do by these Presents further grant and assign unto The corporation of the Mayor Councillors and citizens of the City of Caulfield the supporters following that is to say: **On either side of a dragon wings inverted sable the underside of the wings body and tail Or armed and langued Gules gorged with a Mural crown and resting the interior hind leg on a winged Wheel Or, us the same are all in the margin here of more plainly depicted to be borne and used forever hereafter by the corporation of the Mayor, Councillors and Citizens of the City of Caulfield on seals or otherwise the whole according to the Laws of arms in witness whereof we the said Garter, Clarenceux and Norroy and Ulster King of Arms have to these presents subscribed Our Names and affixed the Seals of Our Several Offices this First day of April in the Twenty Sixth Year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lady Elizabeth the Second by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great / Britain and Northern Ireland and of Her other**

Realms and Territories Queen, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith and in the year of Our Lord One thousand - nine hundred and seventy one.
